Located near the foothills of some of the best cycling routes in Leinster, roadbikehire rents high quality road bikes. The minimum standard is aluminium frame, carbon forks and Shimano 105 drivetrain.

RoadBike Hire is a mobile service that allows visitors to rent a bike for one day or for a few weeks if required.

The mobile service will drop off and collect from a designated collection point. This service can be offered to your customers to maximise their time in the area and get out and enjoy (with no carbon footprint).

Once your business is approved by Fáilte Ireland as eligible for the COVID-19 Safety Charter you will be free to display this status throughout your business premises and online platforms
