

RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 145

LEADER: I will extol Thee, my God, O King; and I will bless Thy name for ever and ever.

PEOPLE: Every day will I bless Thee; and I will praise Thy name for ever and ever.

PEOPLE: To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, & the glorious majesty of His kingdom.

LEADER: Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Thy dominion endureth throughout all generations.

PEOPLE: My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord; & all flesh bless His holy name for ever & ever.
