RESPONSIVE READING
“Life & Victory” - Romans 6:1-13

LEADER: What shall I say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?
PEOPLE: God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
LEADER: Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into His death?
PEOPLE: Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into His death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
LEADER: For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection:
PEOPLE: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
LEADER: For he that is dead is freed from sin.
PEOPLE: Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him:
LEADER: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.
PEOPLE: For in that He died, He died unto sin once; but in that He liveth, He liveth unto God.
LEADER: Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
PEOPLE: Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
LEADER: Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin:
PEOPLE: But yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.
