### **Responsive Reading # 1**

LEADER: As the first streaks of dawn stretch across the charcoal sky, the first day of the week makes know its presence.

PEOPLE: Mary Magdalene and the other Mary go wearily to the tomb where Jesus was placed three days earlier

LEADER: For those close to Jesus, it had been a long and exhausting three days.

PEOPLE: The entire country seemed exhausted, worn out, completely beaten down.

LEADER: As they approached the tomb, a great earthquake rumbled through the earth, shaking the very marrow of the bones!

PEOPLE: Then the angel of the Lord came down from heaven

LEADER: He rolled back the huge stone that had been placed in front of the tomb – the same rock that had taken an army of men to set in place!

PEOPLE: The angel sat upon the rock.

LEADER: His face and his features were as lightening - bright and electric! His clothing was pure white - like new-fallen snow in the brightness of high noon

PEOPLE: Then the angel spoke to the frightened women and said:

LEADER: “Please do not be afraid of me. I know that you came here to see Jesus, but He is not here. He has risen from the dead and is alive!”

PEOPLE: Alive! Jesus is alive!

LEADER: Yes, alive! Jesus is alive!

PEOPLE: He is alive and has risen from the dead!

ALL: Jesus is alive!

### **Responsive Reading # 2**

LEADER: A remarkable event had taken place!

PEOPLE: Christ has risen from the dead!

LEADER: An event never before or since matched.

PEOPLE: He has risen from the dead!

LEADER: Jesus, who was once dead, is now alive!

PEOPLE: He has risen from the dead!

LEADER: He has risen that I might one day live again.

PEOPLE: He has risen from the dead!

LEADER: He is alive and present here – today – right now with us. He is with us right now as we celebrate His resurrection.

PEOPLE: He is risen from the dead!

LEADER: He is here in our midst, right now!

PEOPLE: We rejoice that He is risen from the dead!

LEADER: Let us rejoice and sing praises to Him!

PEOPLE: He has risen from the dead!

LEADER: Rejoice! The Lord is our risen King!

### **Responsive Reading # 3**

LEADER: The angel of God told the 2 Mary’s what to do next.

PEOPLE: Now go your way quickly and tell the disciples that Jesus is no longer chained by the irons of death. He is free! He is alive!

LEADER: You will find Jesus in Galilee for He has already gone there ahead of you.

PEOPLE: The angel then vanished – in an instant.

LEADER: Mary Magdalene and the other Mary looked at each other, uncertain, yet certain of what had happened.

PEOPLE: Then they ran from the burial place terribly  
frightened, but full of excitement. They now knew  
the new truth!

LEADER: Jesus is alive and risen from the dead!

### **Responsive Reading # 4**

LEADER: And now, it is up to us.

PEOPLE: What do you mean, up to us?

LEADER: We must celebrate His resurrection in our daily  
living.

PEOPLE: How do we do this?

LEADER: By loving...by sharing...

PEOPLE: By giving...by reaching out...

LEADER: By sharing the good news of salvation through  
faith in Christ to all who will listen.

PEOPLE: By giving ourselves, our talents, our abilities,  
our money, our time...

LEADER: To others who hurt and how need help in coming  
to God through His son, Jesus Christ.

PEOPLE: By celebration...with joy...with gladness...with  
thanksgiving...with praise...with excitement!

LEADER: Yes, it is up to us to celebrate His presence in our  
lives every day.

PEOPLE: We will begin today!

LEADER: All of us must begin today to celebrate His  
resurrection. He is alive! He is risen!

ALL: He is risen! He is alive! He is here! Praise His name!
