However, Gather is not a place for conversations, discussions, and behavior that are intentionally inappropriate, off-topic, disruptive, or abusive.

Gather defines inappropriate behavior as any form of verbal or physical abuse, the use of derogatory or discriminatory language, gestures or actions, any form of harassment, racism, sexism, or any other targeted comments which are intended to cause personal offense to another Gather participant either

in-person at the event or through social media channels, including but not limited to comments via Gather platforms or the violation of any Swedish law.

Gather may take action in its discretion against any individual(s) or group(s) it believes fail to meet the standards set forth in this Code of Conduct, including but not limited to revoking the violating parties' credentials without refund.

Please contact conduct@gatherfestival.com if you believe you've observed or experienced a violation of this Code of Conduct, and Gather will work to assess the situation and to respond as soon as possible. Please remember that notifying Gather does not constitute or replace a notification to local law enforcement.
