# Live Respectfully Distance Learning Style

All online interactions (comments, posts, emails, pictures, etc.) must be school-appropriate. Respect your teachers, classmates, & yourself!

## Respect Teachers By:

- Checking email and Google Classroom daily and responding to teachers when needed.
- Only commenting on the Google Classroom **stream** unless the teacher expressly asks you to comment in another manner or platform. All other communication with the teacher can happen through email, Remind, or in the activity/document.
- Muting your microphone unless the teacher asks you to unmute it.
- Remembering that comments on Google Classroom are stamped with the time, student's name, and student's ID.
- Completing work in a timely manner by the instructor's due date.

## Respect Classmates By:

- Commenting appropriately. These forums and platforms are for positive commentary that is focused on the learning.
- Addressing the prompt, specifics from a question, and/or specifics from a comment, **NOT a classmate or instructor**. *It's okay to disagree, but be critical of the opposing position, not the person. Wait for pauses to turn on your microphone and speak.*

## Respect Yourself By:

- Logging off your device when you are not working on schoolwork. In the end, you are the one responsible for all activity (comments, visuals, etc) on your device.
- Staying on school-appropriate sites on the Chromebook. Remember, all District-owned Chromebook activity can be viewed by the District.
- Taking care of your Chromebook. You are responsible for it and will return it when Distance Learning ends.
