Start dates

- Tuesday, April 13th/Wednesday, April 14th - Grades 9 & 10
- Thursday, April 15th/Friday, April 16th - Grades 11 & 12 (9th & 10th continue in hybrid)

Masks

- Masks must be worn **properly** by all students and staff while on campus (including outside the building) and in busses.

Social Distancing

- Students and staff will maintain social distancing.
- Close proximity with others (under 6 feet) must be limited to 15 minutes or less.

Sanitizing

- Wash your hands and use hand sanitizer frequently.
- Desks will be sanitized between classes.

Passing Times & Restroom Use

- Passing times are five minutes and students are expected to head directly to their next class.
- Students are expected to social distance themselves and keep to the right while walking in the halls.
- Restroom use will be limited to one student at a time per class.

What to Bring

- Chromebook or personal device (fully charged) and charger.
 - Students need to bring the device they know best and are most comfortable with, including their own personal device if they choose. However, students using their personal device agree to the following:
 - Students must take full responsibility for their device. SKPS is not responsible for the security, support, usage charges, damage, or theft of personal equipment.*
 - Use of personal equipment will be subject to the direction of SKPS staff during the school day.*
 - Students may not use their device to take or post images or videos of any person on campus.*
- Paper and writing utensils
- Backpack or bag (**students will not have lockers to use, including PE**)
- Water bottle (drinking fountains will be turned off; however, 3 water bottle stations are open)
 - Drinks will be allowed in class, but not food. Please eat only during breakfast and/or lunch in your designated area.

Breakfast & Lunch

- **ALL** students can get **free breakfast** which can be picked up starting at 9:10. Enter through the exterior cafeteria door. Breakfasts will be eaten in the upper gym.
- **ALL** students have the option to pick up a **free sack lunch** in their designated lunch area.
- Lunch is open campus for grades 9-12.

Illness & Attendance

- If your student feels ill, please have them stay home.

- Students appearing/feeling ill while at school will be escorted to the health room and possibly sent home.
- A school nurse will investigate any possible cases.
- You will be notified if there is concern for exposure.
- Please call the attendance office and excuse your student if they will be absent from school.
- Tardies will be marked.

Transportation

- In order to keep large groups of students from gathering outside, please do not drop students off early. Those getting breakfast can enter the building at 9:10. All others will not be able to enter the building until 9:20.
- For safety reasons, students will be expected to be out of the building by 2:45 and leaving campus.
- Students are discouraged from arriving early or hanging around campus after school due to safety protocols. Remember, doors open at 9:25 and close at 2:45.
