Advisory Board Members make decisions on behalf of the organization and often are as involved as Executive Board Members. Advisory Board members will be elected in January and serve two years (2022-2023) as the Executive Board. Per Article VIII, Section 1 the Advisory Board committee chairmen shall be appointed by the President with the consent of the Executive Board. The time commitment is moderate as you must be available to attend meetings and work alongside the State Executive Board outside of the meetings.

_____ **AMERICANISM CHAIR** - Chairperson dedicated to creating educational programs, resources and projects which circle around fostering respect for the Flag of the United States of America as well as ensuring proper flag protocol at all events.

_____ **ARMED SERVICES & VETERANS CHAIR** – Chairperson dedicated to all veterans issues and supporting veterans members as well as educating general members. Preferably: this chair is a current or former service member.

_____ **BYLAWS CHAIR** – Chairperson dedicated to being an expert on the NHFRW, NFRW and State Party Bylaws. Leads a committee when Bylaw amendments are up for consideration.

_____ **CAMPAIGNS & ELECTIONS DIRECTOR** – Chairperson coordinates volunteers to knock doors and make calls for candidates as well as keep track of member candidates who are eligible for endorsements in the General Election.

_____ **CARING FOR AMERICA / COMMUNITY RELATIONS CHAIR** - Chairperson dedicated to caring for the community around us and reach people in need through charity projects, toys for tots, food pantry items, clean ups, organizing greeting the troops, etc.

_____ **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT DIRECTOR** – Chairperson focused on engaging our local communities, towns and counties and sharing our NHFRW mission with them.

_____ **CHAPLAIN** – Chairperson in charge of offering a prayer at all board and membership meetings as well as all State Federation events.

_____ **STATEWIDE FUNDRAISING DIRECTOR** - Chairperson focused on raising money for the State Federation through events, phone banks, creative ideas, etc. This person should have prior experience in raising money and the time, energy and enthusiasm to make it happen and good relationships with potential donors.

_____ **LEGISLATION CHAIR** - Chairperson should preferably be a member of the NH House or the Senate who will inform and educate the Federation on important legislation for the House Republican Caucus as well as speak to the press on behalf of NHFRW legislative issues.

_____ **LITERACY & EDUCATION DIRECTOR** - Chairperson dedicated to educational reform by providing members with knowledge about pending legislation, events and information on what is happening in our communities and what they can do to help from a Literacy and Education standpoint.

_____ **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR** – Chairperson dedicated to recruiting women members to run for State Rep and State Senate as well as mentoring and involving new people and Young Republicans in the organization.

_____ **MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR** - One of the more time consuming positions. The Statewide Membership Director is responsible for being the point person between the Clubs and the State Federation regarding all membership issues and questions. Also responsible for spearheading the effort to create new clubs and membership socials across the state.

_____ **PUBLIC RELATIONS DIRECTOR** - Chairperson duties include spreading the word about events/programming through digital and print as well as encouraging members to submit LTE's and Op-Eds working closely with the Corresponding / Press Secretary. Preferably the person has experience in social media, press correspondence, LTE's, etc.

_____ **EDUCATIONAL & VIRTUAL PROGRAMING CHAIR** - Chairperson dedicated to helping develop programs for NHFRW that are educational and informative. Both virtual and in-person.

_____ **HISTORIAN** - Chairperson duties include organizing all club materials and keeping accurate record of club achievements and accomplishments including news clippings, cards, programs, folders, etc.

_____ **STATEWIDE NEWSLETTER DIRECTOR** - Chairperson responsible for putting together content for a newsletter two times a year and getting

information from each club on their accomplishments for the newsletter as well as the State Federation.

_____ **EVENTS CHAIR** – Organize all NHFRW elaborate in-person events and build a committee to organize/budget each event. Oversee all Events decisions.
