Using CircTRAK[™] Shelf Manager, Queens Library is systematically scanning each of its 62 branches to locate items with problem statuses (missing, in transit, checked out, etc.) and remove them from the shelf for problem resolution. Jason Reddy, Library Application Specialist at Queens, reports that "almost 4,000 problem items have been found so far by scanning 8 branches."

"An entire branch collection can be scanned in less than a day using CircTRAK's™ 'find all items' function. None of the Queens staff have had any difficulty using the wand — the procedure and interface are straightforward," Jason says.

"We're saving time that would have been spent manually searching for problem items on the monthly branch Missing/In Transit reports," Jason continued. "We plan on expanding our use of CircTRAK™ to include weeding materials after we're done with this initial cleaning phase."

Salt Lake County Library's "Treasure Hunt"

"It's like a treasure hunt to find missing items that otherwise might never be found," is how Colleen Medling, Application Support Manager for Salt Lake County Library, describes the library system's use of the CircTRAK™ Shelf Manager. "In fact," she says, "we name our wands after Sherlock characters — Holmes, Watson, Mycroft, etc. — because they are such excellent sleuths."

Originally purchasing just three RFID wands in 2009 to share across the system's 18 branches, almost every Salt Lake County Library branch now has its own. When the library discovered CircTRAK's "Find All Items" capability, the branches replaced printed reports with shelf scans to locate lost, missing, in transit and even missing items no longer in the catalog.

"We also identify lists of items that are ready to be pulled from the collection and simply batch change their status from 'Available' to 'Unavailable.' The wand quickly identifies all those items to gather up far faster than using a printed report."

Joplin Public Library Saving Cost & Time with Inventories

"We used to attempt to inventory one collection annually, and seldom actually finished any inventories," says Linda Cannon, Collection Development Librarian/Circulation Supervisor at Joplin Public Library (MO). "We use the wand for an annual inventory of all collections, saving many, many hours of time."

The CircTRAK™ Shelf Manager is very easy to use to scan each shelf to collect hundreds of barcodes in the hour before the library opens. When a collection is completely scanned, the barcodes are uploaded to the ILS to prepare a report of what wasn't scanned at the shelves to be checked as potentially missing items. "We generally only have a few dozen to check for even in large collections, so we are able to declare items missing in inventory in fairly short order."

Joplin Public finds considerable cost and time savings over the old method of removing each item to scan its barcode. "All in all, I'd say we're pretty darned happy with it!"

"We never made it through all the collections in one year as we can now, and the time savings on RFID scanning are enormous."
