- What does it mean that God has a plan for our lives?
- Does God's call on someone's life always mean full time ministry? Explain.
- What does it mean to answer God's call?
- How can we find out what God is calling us to do?
- What are some of the various callings God might have for someone's life?
- What are some things that can hinder us from doing what God calls us to do?
- What are some implications of the fact that God has a plan for our lives before we are even born?
- What are some implications of the fact that God forms children in the womb?
- Why can we boldly and confidently answer God's call for our lives?
- In what ways does God give us what we need to do what He calls us to do?
- What steps could you take this week to more fully do what you already know God is calling you to do?
