We are a grower of large specimen palms, cycads and tropicals.

Our large specimen trees are individually priced.

We encourage our clients to come and tag their own trees.

Even though we grow things in large containers some trees are deeply rooted through the bottom of the box.

To avoid die back we require lead time on some species to deroot in stages.

Coastally grown trees have prettier, fatter trunks because they grow more slowly in this climate.

Kentias have been shade grown. If placed in full sun, trunk will turn brown.
