SECTION 1 – INTRODUCTION

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide ACHW students clear information about ACHW's position in relation to course deferral, withdrawal and refunds.

SCOPE

The policy applies to prospective ACHW students and current students enrolled in higher education courses with ACHW



SECTION 2 – POLICY AND PROCEDURE

PRINCIPLES

ACHW complies with relevant national and state legislation covering fair trading, competition and consumer affairs particularly Competition and Consumer Act 2010 and Schedule 2 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010

POLICY

- ACHW ensures all students are aware of the terms and conditions of their enrolment. All requests for course deferral, course withdrawal, refunds and special consideration must be made in writing to ACHW
- 2. Where a request for course deferral or withdrawal is made, the student will need to state the reason(s) for the deferral or withdrawal.
- 3. Course fees paid to ACHWare not refundable afterthe Census date for both fee paying students and FEE-HELP students unless special circumstances apply.
- 4. All requests for special consideration must be received within 12 months of the student withdrawing from their unit of study or if the student has not withdrawn, within 12 months of the end of the period in which the unit of study was, or was to be, undertaken.
- 5. When a request is received the student will receive acknowledgement in writing via email from ACHW Student Support that the request has been received.
- 6. All requests received by ACHW will be processed within 21 business days of them being received by Student Support, provided that all the required information has been received.
- 7. ACHW will consider all requests in a consistent, transparent, objectives and unbiased manner.
- 8. Students will be provided with reasons and full explanation in writing for decisions and action taken.
- 9. Students have the right to appeal any decision made by ACHW by consulting the ACHW Grievance Policy for guidance.

COURSE DEFERRALS

- 1. Students may defer their studies and reasons have to be provided to ACHW for the request.
- 2. Students will need to demonstrate how circumstances referred to in their request for deferrals directly impact their studies.
- 3. Applications for deferrals can be made via Student Support at support@achw.edu.au
- 4. Requested deferral periods can vary from 3months to a maximum of 12 months.
- 5. Fees are not refunded to students when an application for deferral has been granted.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL

- 1. Students may withdraw from their course enrolment at any time during their studies.
- 2. Withdrawing from a course does not guarantee refund of fees. A student withdrawingfroma course may remain liable for the payment of the course fees (subject to the terms of enrolment and this policy)
- 3. Students withdrawing from a course prior to completing the qualification will be provided with recognition for any units of competency completed, provided all course fees due have been paid



4. Students considering withdrawing from their coursed are encouraged to contact Student Support prior to deciding and advising ACHW in writing.

REFUNDS

Course fees paid to ACHW are not refundable after the Census date for both fee paying students and FEE-HELP students unless special circumstances apply.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

In situations where the student is not entitled to a refund of the course fees but may meet the requirements for special consideration, the student should first discuss the matter with Student Support:

- A student may apply for special consideration in relation to a refund from ACHW
- Appropriate documentation supporting the claim must be provided it is recommended that students speak with Student Support for guidance before submitting their request

To grant a refund based on grounds of special consideration, ACHW must be satisfied that special circumstances applied to that student and that the circumstances:

- Were beyond the student's control; and
- Did not make their full impact on the student until on or after the enrolment date; and
- Were such that it made it impracticable for the student to complete their course

Specialconsiderationgenerally cannot be considered in the following circumstances:

- Changing jobs
- Resigning or termination from the student's job
- Changing workhours
- Moving address
- Course changes due to a regulatory requirement
- Finding the course more challenging or time consuming than what the student expected
