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UNIFORM CODE 2017

It is expected that all Post-16 students dress in accordance with sixth form uniform code. The student's face, school tie and blouse/shirt must be clearly visible and a lanyard must be worn at all times.

Girls:

- A plain, black, sweater or cardigan, or smart jacket with sixth form lanyard.
- Smart, plain black trousers or knee-length skirt.
- A smart, white/pale blue blouse, to be worn with sixth form tie.
- Smart flat or low-heeled black shoes.
- A black dress may be worn as long as the shirt and tie is clearly visible and it is of appropriate length.

Boys:

- A plain, black v-neck sweater or cardigan, with sixth form lanyard.
- Smart, plain black shoes.
- Smart, plain black trousers.
- A plain blue or white shirt to be worn with sixth form tie.

The Sixth Form Management Team will use their discretion as to whether a student's uniform is acceptable and complying with health and safety standards. The basic test is that the uniform would be appropriate for a professional office.

Students not dressed in line with the code will be sent home to change and expected to make up any lesson time lost.

Additional information:

- Natural hair colour only
- Tattoos must not be visible
- Piercings should be discrete and a small stud may be worn in the nose
