iPad for Learning Option Letter

For our 2021 iPad scheme we will be offering 32GB 10.2" 8th Generation iPads with the new A12 Bionic chip. Our scheme has been improved to make sure that students have access to the most up-to-date device for **five** years of study, we have also sought to make the scheme as accessible and affordable for all parents.

The available options are given below, please read through them carefully as there are significant changes to our previous years' iPad schemes.

Option 1 – Direct Debit Lease and Ownership Scheme

£13 a month Direct Debit for 56 months (31st October 2021 – 31st May 2026) + £40 retainer

This pays for the lease of an iPad for five years with the option of keeping the device at the end of the iPad scheme in April 2025. The £40 retainer will then be retained by the Academy as a transfer of ownership.

After the first three years, in July 2023, the iPad will be replaced with a more up-to-date model to ensure devices are compatible with latest operating systems, safety features and device management systems.

Total amount of lease scheme = **£728.00 (+£40 retainer)**

Option 2 – Outright Purchase

Purchase an iPad device outright with a one-off payment. There would then be an option to use our buy back scheme in July 2024. Where we can offer you the market value of your device and put that against the price of a brand-new device.

The option to buy the device outright, which includes a case, apps and three years insurance up to July 2024 is **£425**.

You can also buy the iPad outright with a case but without insurance for **£340**.

Option 3 - Bring Your Own Device

You child may bring in their own device as long as the iPad runs iOS 13 and above. Your child will then be responsible for managing their own device whilst in the Academy.

Option 4 - Opt Out

If you would like to opt out of the scheme your child will have access to a loan device whilst in the Academy, however the device will not be able to be taken home.

Option 5 – I Would Like to Discuss My Situation

If you would like to opt into the scheme but wish to discuss your situation, we would be happy to call you to discuss the options in more detail.
