GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. SUBJECT

French Touch Academy runs a tennis & school program adapted to players from age 10 to 25, searching to combine intensive tennis & school program, either in a French based or American based high school system. After becoming acquainted with the content of the Tennis Program, having visited the sports facilities and the site of the Academy and having taken note of the catering and accommodation arrangements, the parent(s) or guardians have decided, in conjunction with the student/sports player, to place their children into the French Touch Academy for a period determined by the program selected, on the basis of the specific terms and the prices mentioned in the Academy's registration documents. The Academy's registration documents and these General Terms and Conditions, including the internal rules, together comprise the contract (hereinafter the "Contract").

2. INTERNAL RULES / DISCIPLINE / BEHAVIOUR

The student and his parents or guardians shall receive the internal rules before or upon arrival at the site and declare that they have been duly informed and have obtained all the explanations that they may have required, prior to the signature of the Contract, about the imperative rules of health, safety, behavior and conduct attached to group living outside the student's usual household, which the Academy requires that students comply with. The student hereby undertakes to comply with these rules without restriction or reservation and to observe the internal rules throughout the school year. In particular:

- Students are not allowed to receive private outside guests on the premises of the Academy (unless expressly authorised to do so by the person in charge of the Academy).
- Students must have suitable clothing, bathing suit (bathing trunks), towels and linen in sufficient quantities. Bed linen is provided by the Academy. A laundry service is available to the students.
- The use of unlawful substances (including alcohol) is absolutely prohibited within the Academy.
- Unless the Academy decides otherwise in writing beforehand, each student undertakes to wear the Academy's t-t-shirt, or match shirt during official competitions.
- Students understand that they represent the Academy at all times, whether on site or away, and therefore undertake to represent the Academy and its values

3. PRICES / TERMS OF PAYMENT

The price listed in the registration documents shall be fixed and individual and shall comprise all sports services (tennis playing, physical training and mental preparation, assessments), full board accommodation and meals, and schooling (for the Tennis and School Programme). The price does not comprise the transportation of the students to their home, during the week, over the summer holidays as well as on weekends, for those who require this.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS An initial down-payment of 20% must be paid upon registration, i.e. upon signature of the Contract, by 1 August 2020. This down-payment is designed to cover the administrative and registration costs and the fixed costs of implementing the year's programme. The balance of the price, must be paid by cheque or by wire transfer, either in full by a single payment before the start of the school year, or by trimester the 15th of August before the start of the school, the 15th of December and the 15th of March 2022.

4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS PERTAINING TO CANCELLATION

Cancellation by parents or guardians of the student should be executed before the start of the Programm on serious and legitimate grounds that are backed by suitable evidence, the academy undertakes to refund the school fees paid in advance (please note that administrative fees of a fixed amount of 150 € will apply). Neither the student nor his parents or guardians have the right to cancel the student's registration once the program has started without serious and legitimate grounds backed by suitable evidence. If however the student still decides to abandon the program, the entirety of the tuition fees will remain due. Should the registration of the student be cancelled by his parent or guardians during the first semester on serious and legitimate grounds that are backed by suitable evidence, the academy undertakes not to claim any amount that would have been due for the second semester or to refund the amount corresponding to the second

semester in the event that a single payment had been made. No refund will be made if the student leaves during the second semester.

In the event of early departure from the programme, due to a disabling injury, lasting longer than 6 months, the refund will be paid in proportion to the amount of time spent at the French Touch Academy, backed by the relevant medical evidence (please note administrative fees of a fixed amount of 150 € will apply). The cancellation request must either be sent to the Academy by registered post with acknowledgement of receipt, or handed over in person. If the cancellation is due to a medical impediment, the letter must enclose the appropriate evidence in a sealed envelope for the attention of the Director of the Academy.

Cancellation by the Academy - Should the student's registration or schooling be cancelled by the Academy itself on serious and legitimate grounds that are duly proven, the Academy undertakes to reimburse all of the school fees that may have been paid in advance. The Academy may only cancel the student's registration on serious and legitimate grounds backed by suitable evidence.

5. THE TEAM

The pedagogical team is composed of:

- A "Head Coach" who directs and supervises all the professional tennis coaches, physical and mental trainers,
- A Tennis/Physics pedagogical team,
- A school manager accompanied by a team of teachers, as well as a boarding school manager assisted by educational supervisors.

6. ACCOMMODATION (AS AN OPTION)

The students are accommodated in double, triple or quadruple roomed accommodation equipped with all the necessary facilities. The rooms are cleaned and maintained at least once a week by a team of cleaners. The students undertake not to damage the bungalows that are made available to them. The students are asked not to leave their valuables unattended. The Academy shall not be responsible in case of loss or theft. The activity leaders and night guards shall be in charge of supervising the safety and security of the students. The student are asked to keep their room clean at any time, and can be asked to clean their room by the campus supervisor at any time during the week of the weekend.

Cell phones must be handed over to the on-call supervisors when lights go out at 10:00 pm. The students can pick up their cell phones after breakfast.

7. CATERING

The student's meals shall be provided at the canteen of the Residence "Saint Martin". All the boarding students are required to take their meals there. The students shall have to comply with the standard meal times.

8. TENNIS COACHING

Each student shall receive personal training that is tailored to his level. Prior to joining the Program, the student will undergo a test in order to assess his playing level and ensure that he joins a coaching group that is best suited to his level.

A tournament follow-up in the Hérault region is ensured throughout the school year by the team of coaches.

9. SCHOOLING

The students in the French section shall be taught according to rules of the academy, private school system. External professional teaching staffs are available on site to offer the students continued and sustained educational assistance. Students in the international section will follow the American curriculum. The program covers the entire school year. The hours spent on school work shall be spread out from Monday to Friday and shall be made to fit in with the tennis coaching in the mornings.

10. ACTIVITIES – OUTINGS – TRANSPORTATION

The campus supervisors shall be in charge of organizing and running extra-curricular (non-school and non-sports) activities, Under 18 boarding students must not leave the Academy during the week. Unless the parents or guardians provide otherwise in writing, the boarding students may only leave the Academy for

the weekend on Friday evening / Saturday morning if their parents, guardians or any other person duly authorised by them come to fetch them from the Academy. The students must in any event return to the Academy by 6pm on the Sunday. The students and their parents or guardians shall be responsible for the transportation of the students to and from their home.

11. PUNISHMENT – EXPULSION

The students and their parents or guardians undertake to strictly comply with the Contract, including the internal rules, violation of which will result in disciplinary action being taken which may lead to their expulsion, after consultation with the disciplinary board of the Academy. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, subject to reasonable notice depending on the circumstances, the Academy shall be entitled to suspend or expel any student whose attitude, behavior or clothing is contrary to public morals or likely to jeopardize the safety of any persons or property. In such cases, the parents or guardians shall be kept informed about the problems or wrongdoings that are witnessed, and in case of permanent expulsion, they shall be asked to come to fetch the student and take him away. The student and his parents or guardians shall be given an opportunity to present explanations, which the Academy undertakes to hear with an open mind prior to taking any final decision. In accordance with the law, in the event that damages are owed to the Academy due to the student's punishable behavior, the latter will have to pay the Academy a sum that can reach up to 2 000 €. This amount will be deducted from the sums to be refunded to the student in the case of his expulsion.

12. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

It is up to the parents or guardians to inform the Academy about the physical state of the student if this is likely to have consequences on his sporting activities. The parents or guardians hereby duly authorize the Academy to accomplish whatever acts are necessary in case of hospitalisation or surgical operation. The parents or guardians hereby declare that the physical constitution and the state of health of the student who is in their charge enable him to practice sport in general, and tennis in particular, intensively. The student's parents or guardians have been asked to fill in a health questionnaire which is enclosed with the Registration documents and shall bear the consequences of any incorrect or inaccurate answers, without any remedy against the Academy. Upon arrival at the Academy's site, the student shall bring a medical certificate certifying his aptitude to practice sport as well as a document enabling the Academy to check that he is up-to-date with his immunizations.

13. CIVIL LIABILITY / INSURANCE

The Academy is insured in accordance with article L. 321-1 of the French Sports Code. This insurance policy is designed to cover the Academy against the financial consequences of its civil liability for physical injury, tangible and intangible damage caused to third parties owing to the operation of a sports establishment. The liability of the Academy may only be invoked in case of an accident resulting from a clear failure to comply with safety guidelines or inappropriate use of any devices or other facilities. The Academy cannot under any circumstance be held responsible in case of theft. Moreover, it is strongly advised that the students do not bring valuable items with them on to the site. The student and his parents or guardians must take out a personal civil liability insurance policy, covering the student for all the damage that he might cause to third parties, by his own actions, throughout the Program. Moreover, in accordance with article L. 321-4 of the French Sports Code, the Academy hereby recommends that students take out a personal insurance policy covering any physical injury that their sports activities may give rise to, with the insurance company of their choosing.

14. FORCE MAJEURE

None of the parties shall have to perform their obligations under the Contract in the event of circumstances of force majeure, as defined by article 1148 of the French Civil Code. Should this be the case, the parties shall meet in order to find a satisfactory alternative solution and remedy the situation.

15. DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with French Data Protection Law dated 6 January 1978, the data processing of the student's application shall give the student, his parents or guardians the right to access, rectify and challenge any

use or processing of his personal data in keeping with the terms of that law. In order to exercise this right, the student or his parents or guardians should contact the relevant department of the Academy.

16. IMAGE RIGHTS

The student, or if he is under 18 his parents or guardians, hereby duly authorizes F.T Academy to use his image for the purposes of promoting the sporting activities of F.T Academy and its students and/or players, in France, for a duration of ten (10) years, using the following means of transmission: – Paper medium, notably via posters, signs and billboards or through the press and similar publications (in particular daily, weekly, monthly papers, magazines, reviews, catalogues) – The internet and all means of electronic data communication networks – Airwave or Digital broadcasting services Advertising material, notably brochures, flyers and display units and any other means of point of sale advertising or direct marketing

17. APPLICABLE LAW / SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

This Contract shall be governed by French law. Should any disputes arise in connection with the performance of the Contract or its consequences, they shall be brought before the court with jurisdiction over the defendant.

18. ACCEPTANCE

I have read, understood and accept these General Terms and Conditions of the French Touch Academy, including the internal rules that were provided to me prior to the signature of this document, and I understand that any breach of these General Terms and Conditions and of the internal rules may lead to the expulsion of the student.

19. APPLICABLE VERSION

The French version of these General Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
