

The Live Well Collaborative - Fellowship Program

The Live Well Collaborative is looking for applicants for our one-year fellowship program. The fellowship is for those looking to increase their experience through mastering design-based tools focused on translational research. Our Live Well teams translate user insights into solutions that address real-world barriers to living well across the lifespan. You will co-create solutions designed for users in 16 week-long projects that you will impact from start to finish. Fellows work as part of small multi-disciplinary design-led teams that interact directly with our project sponsors which include Boeing, Cincinnati Children's Hospital, P&G, UC Health, and Council on Aging. Projects require team members with varying backgrounds and talents in design research, motion and graphic communication, user interface design, industrial design, fashion design, biomedical engineering, business, and others depending on the scope of the work.

The Live Well fellowship experience is intended to propel participants into careers in User Experience, Design Research, Strategy, or to deepen their creative, user-focused project skills in their own professional direction. We are looking for individuals with:

- Open Perspective: Excitement to explore new and unfamiliar topic areas.
- Collaborative Mindset: An interest in working across multidisciplinary teams, with stakeholders and project sponsors.
- User-Centered Focus: Partnering directly with users to identify their pain points, contextualize their viewpoints and create a solution that works best for them.
- Ability to Execute Ideas: The drive to turn frameworks into interactions and prototypes.

As a Live Well Fellow you can expect to:

- Serve as a project coordinator or provide assistance to faculty as assistant project leaders.
- Interact with partners and LWC Executive Director to ensure projects are focused and on target.
- Develop, learn, and apply new design research and strategy tools.
- Ideate product, service, or system solutions for challenges you identify.
- Document your experience at Live Well and identify how it will shape your future career.

Fellowship Time Frame + Notes

- Fellowships are the duration of an academic year or 12 month time frame
- After the second semester of fellowship, a mutual decision will be made regarding continuing for a second year.
- Fellows that have spent a cooperative education semester with Live Well, will spend their semester learning Live Well's process and methodologies
- Submissions are ongoing
- This is a 40 hour a week position starting at \$21/hr.

Submission Requirements

- A resume and current portfolio of relevant projects.
- One letter of recommendation from a past supervisor or outside evaluator.
- A summary (cover letter) of less than 500 words of how this position fits into your career goals.
