Reins for Success represents our commitment to expand the reach of our services to at-risk, low-income students. To inspire, empower and connect young people with horses to provide them with lasting tools for living a positive life.

Our Success! "Ann started with TRCHB when she was just a year and a half. She was born with a syndrome called Dandy Walker Syndrome (DWS). One of the ailments of DWS is low muscle tone and balance issues. When Ann started riding, she couldn't walk or stand with help, her verbal skills were minimal, and she had very poor trunk control. Ann's balance immediately improved each week, her trunk support increased, and her verbal communication got better. Within 6 months Ann was cruising around with a walker and talking a mile a minute. Her balance, coordination, and trunk support would never be where it is without TRCHB. Ann is now almost 10 years old and can walk, run, jump, bounce, and talk more than she needs to!"





Sources of Income


