## COVID-19 UPDATE: NO IN-PERSON SUNDAY WORSHIP ON JANUARY 10, 2021

Hello Acts Family!

I hope all of you are doing well physically, emotionally, and spiritually during this ongoing pandemic.

I have a COVID-19 update for our church. I was notified by someone in our church who tested positive for COVID-19 today. To my knowledge this is the first confirmed positive case of COVID-19 at our church so far. I won't be sharing the name to protect this person's privacy. What I can say is that this person is doing well and not exhibiting any symptoms. This person went to get tested because of a co-worker who had recently been in close contact tested positive.

With that being said, I did want to share with all of you the steps we are taking as a church per our safety policy:

#1 We're going to make sure that this church member has all the support and resources needed to quarantine and get better soon.

#2 Through contact tracing, we've identified a few others who may have been in close contact with this person and have given them the proper steps to take to quarantine and/or get tested. If you haven't been notified, then that means we've determined to the best of our ability that you weren't in close contact with this individual. If you're still concerned however, please don't hesitate to call me or message me.

Lastly #3, back in September as we were planning to reopen in-person Sunday worship, I shared with you that, if we did have someone who came in person for worship who later tested positive, that we would take a break from in-person Sunday worship. So, since this individual attended this past Sunday, January 3rd, we'll not have in-person Sunday worship this coming Sunday, January 10th, and we will resume meeting in person on Sunday, January 17th, which will allow 14 days to pass. Now, let me be clear that there are not any requirements that we pause in-person meetings nor do we think anyone who attended that service was at risk of being exposed. Because



of the masks, spaced seating, and social distancing, the risk is minimal according to CDC guidelines. However, in an effort to be overly cautious, and to set a good example to the community, we thought taking a break this Sunday was the right thing to do.

I'm so very thankful for our amazing praise team, media team, Pastor Charles, and our interns who will still be going to church this Sunday to serve the body and livestream the service. Because of their service, Acts Fellowship Church, while we won't be together in person this Sunday, will be worshipping together. There will be no interruption to Corporate Worship and that's something we can all celebrate together.
