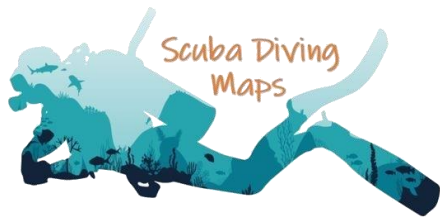


Travel essentials

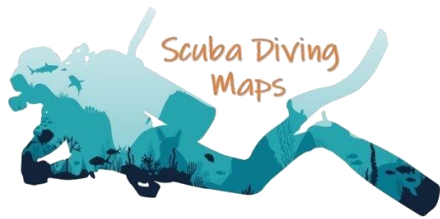

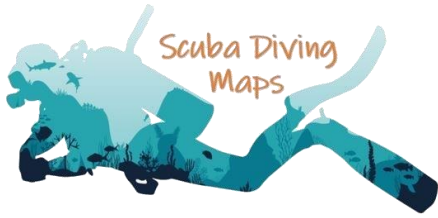
