

Sunday School in 2021 – FAQ

Q: If I come to worship onsite, is there something for my children?

A: We hope to run a covid safe Sunday School, subject to available resources, onsite at 9.00am and 10.30am, in line with English/Mandarin and Cantonese service respectively

Q: What format will onsite Sunday School take?

A: Due to reduced numbers onsite, there will be three mixed age classes:

- preschool/kindy
- years 1-3
- years 4-6

Q: Do I need to register my children for onsite?

A: Yes, register and receive confirmation so we can comply with covid protocols

Q: What if I have registered for onsite and then on the Sunday morning my children cannot attend?

A: Please complete the 'Notification of absence' form

Q: Where do I take my children when I arrive at Church, do I need to check them in?

A: Yes, include them as dependants when scanning QR code. The ushers will give you further instructions when you arrive.

Q: Where do I collect my children after class?

A: In the courtyard.

Q: What if I am still worshipping online?

A: Subject to resources, there will be one zoom for each age bracket (preschool/kindy, years 1-3 and years 4-6) to cater for kids from all three services, ie 9.00 English, 9.00 Mandarin and 10.30 Cantonese.

Q: What time are the online classes?

A: TBA. We are currently canvassing to see what is most convenient for families as it depends if devices are available, and if parents need to help younger children.
