We will provide professional leadership, ministry opportunities, logistical planning, and all the organizational support needed for a short-term mission trip that accomplishes responsible and effective ministry and a life changing experience for every participant. Essential components of a Boost Mission Trip:

- Ministry opportunities that make a genuine and positive impact in the ministry location
- Strong partnerships with local ministries and ministry leaders
- Training and preparation for each trip participant
- Spiritual guidance for each participant throughout the trip
- Immersive cross cultural experience
- Daily schedule well planned and managed to maximize the experience

- Daily “Quiet Times” with assigned passages with prayer time and group discussions
  - Relevant training for the ministry at hand
  - Relevant teaching for the spiritual growth and development of each participant
  - Opportunities to deepen relationships with fellow team members
  - Opportunities to experience local culture, heritage, and recreation
  - Adequate rest and three meals a day
  - Trip debriefing to effectively prepare the participants to transition home.
- Seeking to help participants:
- Minimize reverse culture shock
  - Continue to grow through the lessons God taught them on the trip
  - Develop a vision for how God can continue to use them to serve Him after they come home

Some policies and guidelines that come with a Boost Mission Trip:

- Participants/minors travel in groups of no less than three people
- No drugs, tobacco, or alcohol is to be consumed by any member of the team, including leadership
- No tattoos, body modification, piercings, or extreme aesthetic changes during the trip. “How they come is how they go.”
- Basic dress code requirements are laid out by Reign Ministries and may be adapted to fit the ministry location

Sample Daily Schedule

- 7:30 Team Wakeup
- 8:00–8:30 Breakfast
- 8:30–9:30 Personal prayer and bible study time
- 9:30–10:30 Group discussion/group teaching time
- 10:30–11:30 Prep for ministry and pack lunch
- 11:30–5:00 Ministry and outreach. Includes breaks for lunch and transition times
- 5:30–6:30 Team dinner time
- 6:30–8:30 Cleanup and free time
- 8:30–10:00 Team time and debriefing the day
- 10:30 Lights out

\*The daily schedule varies significantly based on ministry needs, transportation, and needs of the team.
