Library Report:

A discussion was held about the incidents of graffiti in the library. One of the kids had been caught on camera. The Board did not feel that they want to get the police involved. They asked that the kid be offered either a 2 week ban or 2 hours of volunteer service at the library.

Business:

Reference Policy – the Board reviewed the reference policy, no changes were made.

Intellectual Freedom Review – Laura gave a brief presentation on intellectual freedom and the role of libraries and the board. There was a discussion that the Board Bylaws should be amended to adopt the City's public comment policy.

Acquisitions Policy – The Board approved the changes recommended by the Director, including forming a committee for requests for reconciliation and placing a limit on the number of times a specific title can be reviewed. Van Thompson made the motion, Debbie VanderBeke seconded. Motion carried.
