4 Share


Materials: None

- **How do you think Adam and Eve felt when they talked to God after they disobeyed Him?** *Ashamed, sad, embarrassed, like they ruined everything*
- **How does it make you feel knowing that God has a plan, even when things feel messed up?** *Good, safe, thankful, loved*
- **What is one way we can remind ourselves that God has a plan?** *We can read His Word, look at His creation, talk to other Christians about how good God is*






