90 REVELATIONS OF JESUS IN REVELATION

There are 24 distinct descriptions in Revelation 1, 18 descriptions in Revelation 2-3, **totaling 42**. Since 12 are repeated there are 30 unique descriptions of Jesus in these first three chapters of Revelation.

There are **90 descriptions** of Jesus in the entire book of Revelation.

In Revelation 1:5-7, there are 7 descriptions of Jesus listed:

1. Jesus (Rev. 1:5)
2. Christ (Rev. 1:5)
3. Faithful and true witness (Rev. 1:5; 3:7, 14)
4. Firstborn from the dead (Rev. 1:5) similar to “the First” (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)
5. Ruler of the kings of the earth (Rev. 1:5) similar to King of kings (Rev. 19:16)
6. Him who loved us and washed us and made us kings and priests (Rev. 1:5-6)
7. He is coming with clouds (Rev. 1:7; Rev 3:11)—one who intervenes into history—not silent

In Revelation 1:10-18, there are 17 descriptions of Jesus listed:

1. Loud voice, as of a trumpet (Rev. 1:10) similar to a faithful witness
2. His voice as the sound of many waters (Rev. 1:15)
3. I am the Alpha (Rev. 1:11; 22:13)
4. I am the Omega (Rev. 1:11; 22:13)
5. I am the First (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)
6. I am the Last (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)
7. In the midst of the seven lampstands (Rev. 1:13; 2:1)
8. Son of Man (Rev. 1:13) Dan. 7:13-14
9. Garment to the feet (high priest) and girded about the chest with a golden band (Rev. 1:13)
10. His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow (Rev. 1:14)
11. His eyes like a flame of fire (Rev. 1:14; 2:18)
12. His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace (Rev. 1:15; 2:18)
13. He had in His right hand seven stars (Rev. 1:16, 20; 2:1; 3:1)
14. Out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword (Rev. 1:16; 2:12)
15. His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength (Rev. 1:16)
16. I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore (Rev. 1:18; 2:8)
17. He has the keys of the kingdom: I have the keys of Hades and of Death (Rev. 1:18; 3:7)

In Revelation 2-3, there are 18 descriptions of Jesus (*the last 6 in the list are not in Rev. 1*):

1. Who holds the 7 stars in His right hand (Rev. 2:1; 3:1)
2. Who walks in the midst of the 7 golden lampstands (Rev. 2:1)
3. The First (Rev. 2:8)
4. The Last (Rev. 2:8)

5. Who was dead and came to life (Rev. 2:8)
 6. He who has the sharp two-edged sword (Rev. 2:12, 16) (also Rev. 1:16; 19:15, 21)
 7. Eyes like a flame of fire (Rev. 2:18)
 8. Feet like fine brass (Rev. 2:18)
 9. Has the seven Spirits of God (Rev. 3:1)
 10. He has the key of David (Rev. 3:7)
 11. The Faithful Witness (Rev. 3:14)
 12. The Beginning of the creation of God (Rev. 3:14)
 13. ***The Son of God (Rev. 2:18)***
 14. ***I will come upon you as a thief (Rev. 3:3)***
 15. ***I am coming quickly (Rev 3:11)***
 16. ***The True Witness (Rev. 3:7, 14)***
 17. ***The Amen (Rev. 3:14)***
 18. ***He who is holy (Rev. 3:7)***

90 descriptions of Jesus in Revelation: 42 in Rev. 1-3; 7 in Rev. 5-6; 2 in Rev. 7; 2 in Rev. 11; 2 in Rev. 12; 1 in Rev. 13; 5 in Rev. 14; 8 in Rev. 15; 1 in Rev. 16; 14 in Rev. 19; and 7 in Rev. 22.

1. The Lion of the tribe of Judah (Rev. 5:5)
 2. The Root of David (Rev. 5:5)
 3. A Lamb having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God (Rev. 5:6)
 4. A male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron (Rev. 12:5)
 5. The Lamb slain from the foundation of the world (Rev. 13:8)
 6. A Lamb standing on Mount Zion...with 144,000 saints (Rev. 14:1)
 7. On the cloud sat One like the Son of Man with a golden crown (Rev. 14:14-16)
 8. He thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped (Rev. 14:16)
 9. The Lord God Omnipotent reigns (Rev. 19:6) (Greek: pantokrator or Almighty)
 10. The marriage of the Lamb has come (Rev. 19:7): Bridegroom God
 11. Behold, a white horse...and He who sat on him (Rev. 19:11): He rides a white horse
 12. Called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11): the faithful witness
 13. In righteousness He judges and makes war (Rev. 19:11)
 14. His eyes were like a flame of fire (Rev. 19:12)
 15. He had a name that no one knew except Himself (Rev. 19:12): mysterious
 16. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood (Rev. 19:13): sword
 17. His name is called The Word of God (Rev. 19:13)
 18. Many crowns on His head as King of the saints and King of kings (Rev. 19:12, 16; 15:3)
 19. I am the Beginning and the End (Rev. 22:13 is listed in Rev. 3:14)
 20. I am the Root of David and the Offspring of David (Rev. 22:16)
 21. I am the Bright Star and the Morning Star (Rev. 22:16)
