90 Descriptions of Jesus in Revelation

There are 24 distinct descriptions in Revelation 1, 18 descriptions in Revelation 2-3, **totaling 42**. Since 12 are repeated there are 30 unique descriptions of Jesus in these first three chapters of Revelation. There are **90 descriptions** of Jesus in the entire book of Revelation.

Jesus (Rev. 1:5)

Christ (Rev. 1:5)

Faithful and true witness (Rev. 1:5; 3:7, 14)

Firstborn from the dead (Rev. 1:5) similar to “the First” (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)

Ruler of the kings of the earth (Rev. 1:5) similar to King of kings (Rev. 19:16)

Him who loved us and washed us and made us kings and priests (Rev. 1:5-6)

He is coming with clouds (Rev. 1:7; Rev 3:11)

Loud voice, as of a trumpet (Rev. 1:10)

His voice as the sound of many waters (Rev. 1:15)

I am the Alpha (Rev. 1:11; 22:13)

I am the Omega (Rev. 1:11; 22:13)

I am the First (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)

I am the Last (Rev. 1:11, 17; 2:8; 22:13)

In the midst of the seven lampstands (Rev. 1:13; 2:1)

Son of Man (Rev. 1:13) Dan. 7:13-14

Garment to the feet (high priest) and girded about the chest with a golden band (Rev. 1:13)

His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow (Rev. 1:14)

His eyes like a flame of fire (Rev. 1:14; 2:18)

His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace (Rev. 1:15; 2:18)

He had in His right hand seven stars (Rev. 1:16, 20; 2:1; 3:1)

Out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword (Rev. 1:16; 2:12)

His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength (Rev. 1:16)

I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. (Rev. 1:18; 2:8)

Has the seven Spirits of God (Rev. 3:1)

He has the key of David (Rev. 3:7)

The Faithful Witness (Rev. 3:14)

The Beginning of the creation of God (Rev. 3:14)

The Son of God (Rev. 2:18)

I will come upon you as a thief (Rev. 3:3)

I am coming quickly (Rev. 3:11)

The True Witness (Rev. 3:7, 14)

The Amen (Rev. 3:14)

He who is holy (Rev. 3:7)

The Lion of the tribe of Judah (Rev. 5:5)

The Root of David (Rev. 5:5)

A Lamb having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God (Rev. 5:6)

A male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron (Rev. 12:5)

The Lamb slain from the foundation of the world (Rev. 13:8)

A Lamb standing on Mount Zion...with 144,000 saints (Rev. 14:1)

On the cloud sat One like the Son of Man with a golden crown (Rev. 14:14-16)

He thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped (Rev. 14:16)

The Lord God Omnipotent reigns (Rev. 19:6) =

The marriage of the Lamb has come (Rev. 19:7): =

Behold, a white horse...and He who sat on him (Rev. 19:11):

Called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11)
