## May is known as month of Mary - Why the Daily Rosary?



Our Lady has 117 titles. She selected this title at Fatima: **“I am the Lady of the Rosary.”** St. Francis de Sales said the greatest method of praying is to Pray the Rosary. St. Thomas Aquinas preached 40 straight days in Rome, Italy on just the Hail Mary. St. John Vianney, patron of priests, was seldom seen without a rosary in his hand. “The rosary is the scourge of the devil”-Pope Adrian VI. “The rosary is a treasure of graces”-Pope Paul V. Padre Pio the stigmatic priest said: “The Rosary is THE WEAPON”. Pope Leo XXIII spoke 38 times about our Lady and the Rosary. He prayed 15 decades daily. St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort wrote: “The rosary is the most powerful weapon to touch the Heart of Jesus, Our Redeemer, who so loves His Mother.” St. Pope John Paul II presented the Rosary as an outstanding way to contemplate the face and mysteries of Christ. He proclaimed a “Year of the Rosary”, which extended from October 2002 to October 2003.

## ST. PHILIP AND ST. JAMES

**MAY 3**

**Philip** was born in Bethsaida in Galilee and was one of the 12 Apostles that Jesus called. Immediately, Philip began to convert others, finding his friend Nathaniel and telling him that Jesus was the one whom Moses and the other prophets had foretold. Following the

resurrection of Jesus, Philip was sent with his sister Mariamne and Bartholomew to preach in Greece, Phrygia, and Syria. through a miraculous healing and his preaching Philip converted the wife of the proconsul of the city. This enraged the proconsul, and he had Philip, Bartholomew, and Mariamne all tortured. Philip and Bartholomew were then crucified upside-down, and Philip preached from his cross. As a result of Philip's preaching the crowd released Bartholomew from his cross, but Philip insisted that they not release him, and Philip died on the cross. Another legend is that he was martyred by beheading in the city of Hierapolis, present day Turkey. **James the Lesser** is called “Lesser” because he was younger than the other Apostle by the same name, James the Great. James, a cousin of Jesus,

and after Jesus' Ascension into heaven, became the head of the Church in Jerusalem. He was martyred by being thrown from the roof of the Jerusalem temple and then stoned and beaten to death as he prayed for his murderers. He died in the year 62 A.D.

## **ST. FRANÇOIS DE LAVAL – MAY 6**

St. François-Xavier de Montmorency-Laval (30 April 1623 - 6 May 1708) was the first Roman Catholic bishop of Quebec and was one of the most influential men of his day. He was appointed when he was 36 years old by Pope Alexander VII. He was a member of the Montmorency family. He was beatified in 1980 by Pope John Paul II. He was canonized on April 3, 2014 by Pope Francis.

### **What is Christian Detachment?**

*"Everything that exists is a gift from God. Yet oftentimes we look to the things and creatures created by God for a satisfaction and fulfillment that only God Himself can provide. When the soul wraps itself around the things and the people of this world, looking for satisfaction or fulfillment that only God can give, it produces a distortion in itself, and in others as well. Many spiritual writers call the process of unwinding this possessive, self-centered, clinging, and disordered seeking of things and persons 'detachment'. The goal of the process of detachment is not to stop loving the things and people of this world, but, quite to the contrary, to love them even more truly in God, under the reign of Christ, in the power of the Holy Spirit. Things and people become even more beautiful and delightful when we see them in this light. There are almost always painful dimensions to this process of 'letting go' in order to love more, but it's the pain of true healing and liberation. Christian detachment is an important part of the process by which we enter into a realm of great freedom and joy."*
