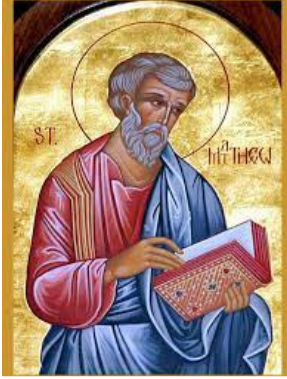

Feast of Apostle Matthew - September 21

Matthew, son of Alphaeus, lived at Capernaum on Lake Genesareth (Sea of Galilee). Matthew was a tax-collector and must have been hated by the Jews for having entered the civil service of their Roman conquerors. When Jesus called Matthew, as he sat at his customs post, Matthew rose up and followed him, leaving everything behind him except one thing--his pen. Matthew used his literary skill to compile an account of the teachings of Jesus. He wrote especially for members of the Jewish people to show them that the prophecies of the Old Testament were fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

St. Matthew preached among the Jews for fifteen years following the Resurrection and Ascension of our Blessed Jesus. He is the author of the Gospel that bears his name, which he wrote to convince the Jews that Jesus Christ was the Messiah promised to Israel. According to tradition, St. Matthew the Apostle brought the Gospel to Syria, Media, Persia, Parthia, and finished his preaching in Ethiopia with a martyr's death. He is the patron of guards, bankers, accountants, security forces, and stock brokers. His feast day is September 21st.



Saint Padre Pio of Pietrelcina - September 23

Francesco Forgione, Padre Pio of Pietrelcina, entered the novitiate of the Capuchin friars at age 15, and was ordained at age 22 in 1910. While praying before a cross, he received the stigmata, the first priest ever to be so blessed. He would hear confessions by the hour, reportedly able to read the consciences of those who held back. Padre Pio founded the House for the Relief of Suffering in 1956, a hospital that serves 60,000 a year. His canonization miracle involved the cure of Matteo Pio Colella, age 7, the son of a doctor who worked in the hospital founded by Padre Pio. During a prayer vigil attended by Matteo's mother and some Capuchin friars, the child's condition improved suddenly. When he awoke from a coma, Matteo said that he had seen an elderly man with a white beard and a long, brown habit, who said to him: "Don't worry, you will soon be cured." The miracle was approved by the Congregation and Pope John Paul II canonized him 16, June, 2002.

An empty boat.....

A monk decides to meditate alone, away from his monastery.

He takes his boat out to the middle of the lake, moors it there, closes his eyes and begins his meditation.

After a few hours of undisturbed silence, he suddenly feels the bump of another boat colliding with his own.

With his eyes still closed, he senses his anger rising, and by the time he opens his eyes, he is ready to scream at the boatman who dared disturb his meditation.

But when he opens his eyes, he sees it is an empty boat that had probably got untethered and floated to the middle of the lake.

At that moment, the monk achieves self-realization, and understands that the anger is within him; it merely needs the bump of an external object to provoke it out of him.

From then on, whenever he came across someone who irritated him or provoked him to anger, he reminded himself :

"The other person is merely an empty boat. The anger is within me....."

In reality, we all have the anger within us, all the time, all it needs is someone, like the empty boat, to provoke it.
