## **World Mission Sunday, October 24, 2021**

Pope Francis, in his message for World Mission Day, 2021 invites everyone to reflect up on Acts 4:20, “*We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard.*” Everything about Christ reminds us that he knows well our world and its need for redemption, and calls us to become actively engaged in this mission: “Go therefore to the

highways and byways, and invite everyone you find” (*Mt 22:9*). No one is excluded, no one need to feel distant or removed from this compassionate love.

The history of evangelization began with the Lord’s own passionate desire to call and enter into friendly dialogue with everyone, just as they are (cf. *Jn 15:12-17*). The Apostles are the first to tell us this; they remembered even the day and the hour when they first met him: “It was about four o’clock in the afternoon” (*Jn 1:39*). Experiencing the Lord’s friendship, watching him cure the sick, dine with sinners, feed the hungry, draw near to the outcast, touch the unclean, identify with the needy, propose the Beatitudes and teach in a new and authoritative way, left an indelible mark on them, awakening amazement, expansive joy and a profound sense of gratitude. The prophet Jeremiah describes this experience as one of a consuming awareness of the Lord’s active presence in our heart, impelling us to mission, regardless of the sacrifices and misunderstandings it may entail (cf. *20:7-9*). Love is always on the move, and inspires us to share a wonderful and hope-filled message: “We have found the Messiah” (*Jn 1:41*). This mission has always been the hallmark of the Church, for “she exists to evangelize” (SAINT PAUL VI, [\*Evangelii Nuntiandi\*](#), 14).

On World Mission Day, which we celebrate each year on the penultimate Sunday of October, we recall with gratitude all those men and women who by their testimony of life help us to renew our baptismal commitment to be generous and joyful apostles of the Gospel. Let us remember especially all those who resolutely set out, leaving home and family behind, to bring the Gospel to all those places and people athirst for its saving message.

To be on mission is to be willing to think as Christ does, to believe with him that those around us are also my brothers and sisters. May his compassionate love touch our hearts and make us all true missionary disciples.

May Mary, the first missionary disciple, increase in all the baptized the desire to be salt and light in our lands (cf. *Mt 5:13-14*).

## **SAINT SIMON & SAINT JUDE - CTOBER 28**

The names of Simon and Jude appear in New Testament lists of the apostles but little else is known about either. Since there are two apostles named Simon and two named Judas (Luke 6.14-16 and Acts 1.13). These are distinguished as Simon and Zealot and Judas the son (or the brother) of James, the others being Simon Peter and Judas Iscariot.

Simon is surnamed the Cananaean or the Zealot, names which refer to his zeal for the Law. Jude (Judas) is also called Thaddeus (Matthew 10.4 and Mark 3.18); the one mention of him outside of the lists is in John (14.22-23) where he is referred to as "Judas (not Iscariot)."

Traditionally, both these apostles suffered martyrdom. In a later tradition, St. Jude became a patron saint of so-called hopeless causes.

**BOOK OF THE NAMES OF THE DECEASED** During the month of **November** as is our tradition we display the **Book of the Dead** in the sanctuary and pray for the departed souls.
