Do I ever use my tongue as a weapon?

Some people have never learned to keep their mouths shut. Their brains seem to be directly attached to their tongues. They blurt out whatever pops into their heads with little or no regard for the consequences. Learning to govern our tongues may be one of the most difficult lessons any of us have to learn. Our tongues get us into more trouble than does any other part of our bodies. “However, large ships are...they are directed by very small rudders on whatever course the steersman’s impulse may select. The tongue is something like that. It is a small member yet it makes great pretensions,” says St. James (*St. James 3.5*) If we can learn to keep our mouth shut when our words would be hurtful or harmful, we will have gone a long way toward learning to self-control and self-discipline we all desire to have.
