FEAST OF THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD



The Ascension of Our Lord, which occurred 40 days after Jesus Christ rose from the dead on Easter, is the final act of our redemption that Christ began on Good Friday. On this day, the risen Christ, in the sight of His apostles, ascended bodily into Heaven (Luke 24:51; Mark 16:19; Acts 1:9-11).

The reality of Christ's Ascension is so important that the creeds (the

basic statements of belief) of Christianity all affirm, in the words of the Apostles' Creed, that "He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead." The denial of the Ascension is as grave a departure from Christian teaching as is denial of Christ's Resurrection. Christ's bodily Ascension fore-shadows our own entrance into Heaven not simply as souls, after our death, but as glorified bodies, after the resurrection of the dead at the Final Judgement. In redeeming mankind, Christ not only offered salvation to our souls but began the restoration of the material world itself to the glory that God intended before Adam's fall. Scott Richer



St. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi, May 25


Born Catherine, Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi was born into a prominent family in Florence in 1566. Rejecting her parents' proposed suitors, she convinced her family of

her religious vocation and at 17 became a Carmelite nun. Her biography, compiled by her confessor, gives a detailed account of her intense spiritual journey with its periods of desolation and ecstasy. Mary Magdalene had the gifts of prophecy and healing. She died in 1607 and her uncorrupted body is enshrined in the convent church.

Born in Florence in 1515, St. Philip Neri was known for his impulsiveness and sense of humour from a young age. Although he was in line to become a successful businessman, he abandoned his career for a life of prayer and study, spending much of his time giving spiritual direction to the youth. He later founded

the Oratorians, where reading, singing, and charitable works were to be practiced. He is remembered for his humour and his joyful love of God. St Philip Neri is the patron of home missions, supported in Canada through the Catholic Missions In Canada. His feast day is May 25.
