### Lakes Report

#### Sandshores Lake Aeration is a "Go"

The installation of an aeration system by LakePro on Sandshores Lake was approved by the ELVHA Board at its March meeting. Once approval is received from EGLE we will be in a position to order equipment, have electricity run to the location of the compressor, and begin installation this season.

#### Too Early to Fertilize

Do not fertilize your lawn until the ground has thawed, which will not be in March. The fertilizer will simply wash off into storm drains and into our lakes.

### Spring Cleaning & Maintenance

#### Yard Clean-Up

Yard waste will start being picked up curbside on April 6. Yard waste consists of: leaves and twigs • pine cones • branches under 2" in diameter and 3' long, bundled and tied, weighing less than 40 lbs. Limit 5 bundles/week • small shrubs, shrub clippings, and vines • spent flowers, garden plants, potting soil • grass clippings (It's better if you mow them into your lawn.).

Yard waste should be placed in 35-gallon maximum containers displaying a City of Troy yard waste sticker (available at the DPW on Rochester Rd.) or 30-gallon yard waste paper bags. Containers should not exceed 50 lbs. Yard waste in plastic bags will not be collected — as yard waste or as trash.

#### **Home Maintenance**

Some important spring maintenance items inside and outside your home are:

- Test your sump pump before spring rains come.
- Clean out lint from your dryer screen and vent and from under your dryer.
- Change your furnace filter.
- Change your smoke detector and CO detector batteries.
- Check for loose, curled, or discolored shingles, especially around chimneys and vent pipes and weather seal, if needed.
- Clean out gutters and check to see that they are tight to the fascia board.
