Pricing

If you contact one of the big companies advertising on all of the main networks as we have, you will find that the prices range from .18 cents - .48 cents per square foot.

Let's apply these rates to an average size professional office space of 4000 sq ft.

Lowest

4000 X .18 cents = \$720

Highest

4000 X .48 cents = \$1,920

This space will take one person no more than one hour to complete this job and less than a few dollars in chemical.

The going rate for a 4 bedroom home is around \$200 which will take no more than 30 minutes to sterilize.
