POAC STATE SHOWS – MINNESOTA, IOWA, WISCONSIN EXAMPLE:

Shows can be single or double judged each day over the weekend; fees are smaller per class for single judged shows

- ✓ State shows are a weekend of fun.
 - \$15-35 annual membership fee depending on each state (state membership only-good for all shows) –
 - \$70 annual national membership fee
 - \$5 number fee (pay once per year, good at WI, MN, IA shows)
 - \$45-\$55 stall fee (may include two bales of shavings)
 - \$35-50 camping fee for the weekend at sites, includes electricity
 - \$6 per class per day
 - \$8 state performance fee (\$4 if you show halter only)
 - \$3 office fee (per pony)
- ✓ Pre-entry is not necessary
- ✓ Placings 1st through 6th
- ✓ Ribbons and trophies are available if desired
- ✓ Year-end participation and high point awards for attendance at 50% of state pointed shows
- ✓ Exciting events have been held such as kickball, water balloon games, tailgate parties, potlucks, ride-a-buck, egg n spoon, costume contests, Halloween trick or treating and SO MUCH MORE!



POAC REGIONAL SHOWS-MIDWEST REGIONAL EXAMPLE:

Held annually in the Midwest Region-WI, MN, IA, IL, SD, ND and NE

- ✓ Must be a National POAC member
- ✓ No number fee if you already have a state number
 - \$5 number fee (pay once per year, good at WI, MN, IA shows)
 - \$85 stall fee
 - \$100 camping fee
 - \$8 class fee (pre-entry) \$10 (post-check in entry)
 - \$10 performance fee (\$5 if you show halter only)
 - \$3 office fee (per pony)
 - \$5 equipment fee (per pony if entered in trail, jumping, or games)
- Placings 1st through 8th
- Awesome prizes for class winners and high points!



POAC NATIONAL CLASSIC SHOWS – CENTRAL CLASSIC EXAMPLE:

Two to three Classic Shows held each year (Eastern, Central and Western) – Central Classic is held in Winona, MN

- Must be a National POAC member
 - \$5 number fee (pay once per year, good at WI, MN, IA shows)
 - \$85 stall fee

- \$100 camping fee
- \$20 performance fee (halter only)
- \$25 performance fee
- \$10 performance fee (\$5 if you show halter only)
- \$14 per class (pre-entry) and \$18 per class (post check-in entry)
- \$3 office fee (per pony)
- \$5 equipment fee (per pony if entered in trail, jumping, or games)
- ✓ Placings 1st through 8th - three sets of points!
- ✓ Awesome prizes for class winners and high points!



POAC NATIONAL CONGRESS SHOW:

Premier POAC show held annually. Prices based on 2013 show in Lake St. Louis

- ✓ Must be a National POAC member
 - \$25 National Pony Fee (halter and performance-\$20 if halter only)
 - \$5 equipment fee (per pony if entered in trail, jumping, games)
 - \$15 drug fee (per pony)
 - \$116 stall fee (good for 10 days, includes 2 bales of shavings)
 - \$116 tack stall fee (can be split with others, includes 2 bales of shavings)
 - \$200 flat camping fee for duration of show
 - \$18 per class for pre-entry (\$24 per class if entered at show)
- ✓ You are assigned a number, already incorporated into show fees
- ✓ Futurities/Maturities for youth and adults are offered; pre-entry fees are available!
- ✓ Placings 1st through 10th place
- ✓ Congress Champions win an embroidered jacket and a neck ribbon; Reserve Congress Champions receive a neck ribbon. Great prizes and awards for high point, futurities, Oldest Pony, etc.!
- ✓ Great contests for fun-dog costume contest, goat tying, watermelon seed spitting, and MUCH MORE!



POAC INTERNATIONAL FUTURITIES

Premier Adult POAC show held annually - prices based on 2014 show in Lake St. Louis

- ✓ Must be a National POAC member
- ✓ Nominations are due in early March: \$20 per class
- ✓ Sustaining payments of \$35 per class due in May and September
- ✓ Class fee of \$10 per class due in September
- ✓ Maturities (WP, HUS, Trail) are a one-time pre-entry fee of \$100
 - \$10 Office fee
 - \$15 drug fee
 - \$100 stall fee
 - \$100 tack stall fee
- ✓ Placings 1st through 10th
- ✓ Futurities/Maturities paid out a total of \$84,191.74 in 2013 in 33 classes!
- ✓ Futurity Champions receive an extra- large check, Dale Chavez belt buckle, and of course, money! All top ten finishers win medals.



POAC SHOW AT THE REICHERT CELEBRATION

POA Show sponsored by The Reichert Celebration, held annually in conjunction with other breed shows - Show hosts the premier Western Pleasure Futurity: the McClaren.

- ✓ Last year, the McClaren Futurity winner earned approximately \$1,000 in winnings in 2013, along with the one year use of a Four Star Trailer (3 horse gooseneck) and a Reichert Celebration jacket and a medal!
- ✓ Class winners receive a Reichert Celebration jacket as well as a medal; reserve and third placings get a medal and top ten receive a ribbon.
- ✓ Pre-entry fees for POA are \$12/class (and that's three judges). Compare that to the AQHA show, where pre-entry fees are \$15 per judge per class!
- ✓ Placings 1st through 8th
