VINEYARD NOTES

A combination of two vineyards, the first from Piekensskloof ward in the Citrusdal mountain appellation, situated 520m above sea level on weathered granite. The second vineyard is in the Swartland, from the fertile Koffieklip soils to the north west of Malmesbury.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The wine is pressed and transferred to barrel for fermentation and matured in the same barrels for 11 months (only 1 racking throughout its maturation)

TASTING NOTES

Destemmed and pressed straight to barrel. Natural ferment without any additions for 3 months. Bottled after a single filtration. No fining or stabilisation. At prolonged cold temperatures a harmless sediment might develop. This wine will drink well in its youth but has the potential to be cellared for 7-10 years with ease. A light deposit may occur and is a sign of the wine's authentic approach in how it was made. Bottled April 2017.
