CLAY SOILS. HARVESTED FROM A VINEYARD IN PAARL, DRYLANDS FARMED. PICKED ON TASTE AND ACIDITY TO MAKE A FRESHER STYLE WINE. 2019 VINTAGE, WAS A GOOD VINTAGE CONSIDERING THE DROUGHT THE WESTERN CAPE HAS BEEN EXPERIENCING FOR THE LAST 4 YEARS.

## WINEMAKING NOTES

WHOLE BUNCH PRESSED. NATURAL FERMENTATION. FERMENTED IN STAINLESS STEEL TANKS. 4 MONTHS MATURATION IN STAINLESS STEEL TANKS. TRANSFERRED TO 225L FRENCH OAK BARRELS FOR A FURTHER 2 MONTHS BEFORE BOTTLING. LIGHT FILTRATION AT BOTTLING.
