## **Top Catches**

Watts Bar Lake has top-notch sport fishing, with some of the highest ratings in the TVA system for crappie, black crappie, largemouth bass, and spotted bass. Whether you're a tournament fisherman or a novice, you can set off on your own or hire a local guide.

Depth: 100 feet Preferred Bait: Crafish, small fish Habitat: Rock or sandy bottoms



Depth: 12-20 feet Preferred Bait: Insects, small fish Habitat: Clear still water, in vegetation



Depth: 3-5 feet Preferred Bait: Insects, frogs, minnows Habitat: Clear water, vegetated cover



Depth: 30 feet red Bait: Fishes, nymphs Habitat: Pools, ledges, rocky areas



Depth: 5 feet Preferred Bait: Chicken, crawfish Habitat: Clear water with current

## Float in Roane

Take a fast boat or a slow float through the 39,000 sparkling blue acres of Watts Bar Lake, one of the largest in the Southeast.

Sail or paddle your way along the Tennessee RiverLine, the shimmering blue version of the Appalachian Trail, which takes you on adventures along the Tennessee, with access to the Clinch and Emory Rivers as well. Sandy spots along more than 700 miles of scenic shoreline call out for a picnic, or for more relaxation book some spa time at Whitestone Inn, just a short boat ride from Long Island or Caney Creek Marinas.

Boat, canoe and kayak rentals are available at marinas and parks all along the shoreline and there is an ADA compliant kayak launch at Kingston's Waterfront. Launches and docks provide easy access to some of the best fishing in the eastern U.S., with hot spots for several varieties of bass, record sizes of catfish and crappie, stripers, sunfish, muskie and more. Ready to travel? From here, you can take your boat all the way to the Gulf of Mexico.

Diet: Small mammals, reptiles Habitat: Hardwood stands, swamps, forests Nests: Crook of the main trunk in deciduous trees



Diet: Fish, amphibians, small mammals Habitat: Marshes, swamps, shorelines Nests: Trees, structures



Habitat: Pine forests, woodlands near streams Nests: Forest canopies, near the edges of branches



Diet: Fish, small mammal Habitat: Near wetlands, rivers, coasts Nests: High structures, dead trees

## **Soar in Roane**

Roane County parks and wildlife management areas are great places to enjoy nature's beauty.

Roane County is made for outdoor adventure. With lush green parks, wildlife management areas (WMAs) and refuges, there's never a shortage of places to get away from civilization and wander the ridges and shorelines.

On foot or by bike, our trails will lead you through a natural wonderland. You'll find hotspots for bird watching, like the Gupton Wetlands at Lakeshore Park, where at least 114 species of birds can be found. Lookout for Bald Eagles from the water or while picnicking at Kingston City Park or walking the Heritage Center Greenway.

Bring patience and binoculars to spot gorgeous yellow and black throated green warblers on the Rockwood Forest trail. Ride horseback at Winding Creek Stables or Henry/Stafford Exposition Center in the winter during Open Rides, with horse stalls available to rent weeknights.


