### MAR VISTA FARM + COTTAGES

Amid a much-anticipated season of reopenings, Mar Vista Farm + Cottages is among the flurry of Bay Area hotels and resorts welcoming guests once again. The Gualala destination, reopened under new ownership, along Mendocino County's "secret coast" comprises 11 vintage cottages and a small farm atop 9 scenic acres. ### PALIHOTEL SAN FRANCISCO

One of Palisociety's newest West Coast outposts, Palihotel San Francisco, is finally opening its doors on the tail end of a COVID-19-induced closure, which came shortly after the hotel's debut in February of last year. The sophisticated, 82-room destination inhabits the historic Stockton Street building that was once the Navarre Guest House and, most recently, the Mystic Hotel. Palihotel's interiors fuse the old and the new, achieving an inviting loft-style atmosphere that's distinct from anything else in the city.
