### Directions

LAUNDRY PRESPOTTER: Spray this product directly onto protein based stains, such as those from eggs, chocolate, blood, and grass. Allow spotter to penetrate and saturate stain at least 15 minutes before laundering goods. After appropriate contact time, load linens into machine and launder as usual. WHEN USED AS A PRESOAK: Fill soak bin half full with room temperature water. Add product at recommended amount. Place stained linens in soak bin. For light stains, allow longer contact time. For heavier stains, allow to soak overnight. Change solution daily. CARPET SPOTTER: Blot up liquids before applying this product. Apply to soiled area and allow 15 minutes to 1 hour contact time. Blot up with clean toweling and shampoo carpet according to regular procedure. Do not add other products to this pre-spotter. Consult your local representative for specific instructions.
