Increased of cleaning and sanitizing common areas



Home office (adopted to all the activities that are possible)



Chartered buses circulating with fewer passengers



Application of the screening questionnaire for suppliers



Adoption of quarantine in case of risk of contamination

Caring for our Society



Ensuring the jobs of all direct employees at this time



Donating personal care items, such as toilet paper, napkins, and disposable diapers in Brazil



Ensuring the supply of essential goods



Supporting hospitals in our local communities in Brazil



Ensuring, for a period of 60 days, the continued transfer of 100% of the payroll costs of the third-party service providers whose activities were suspended



Social program to help small-scale farmers sell their products with a home delivery system in 38 communities supported by Suzano's Rural Land Development Program (PDRT) in five Brazilian states



Acquiring 159 ventilators and 1 million medical masks for donation, with support of our Shanghai office, to Brazilian federal and state governments



Supporting the Brazilian company Magnamed in delivering to the federal government 6,500 ventilators by August 2020 in partnership with Positivo Tecnologia, Klabin, Flex, and Embraer



Constructing, together with Veracel, the field hospital in Teixeira de Freitas, Brazil



Partnership with the Technical School (Fatec) of Capão Bonito, Brazil, to produce alcohol gel hand sanitizer



Program to support small-sized suppliers in Brazil







Social program to produce 125,000 masks in local communities for donation in five Brazilian states

Caring for our Logistics and Port Operations



-  Body temperature measurement of truck drivers of the Logistics operation
-  Drivers waiting area in an open place, without agglomerations
-  Mobile sanitation station for Loading/Unloading operations at the Port of Santos
-  Quick response time in the decision making process with constant monitoring of exogenous risks

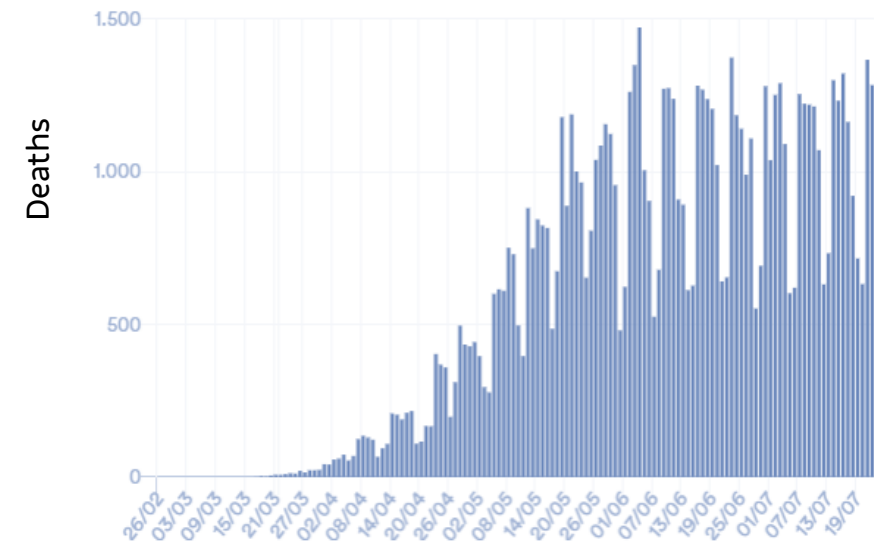

■ Sul	172.556	7,7%

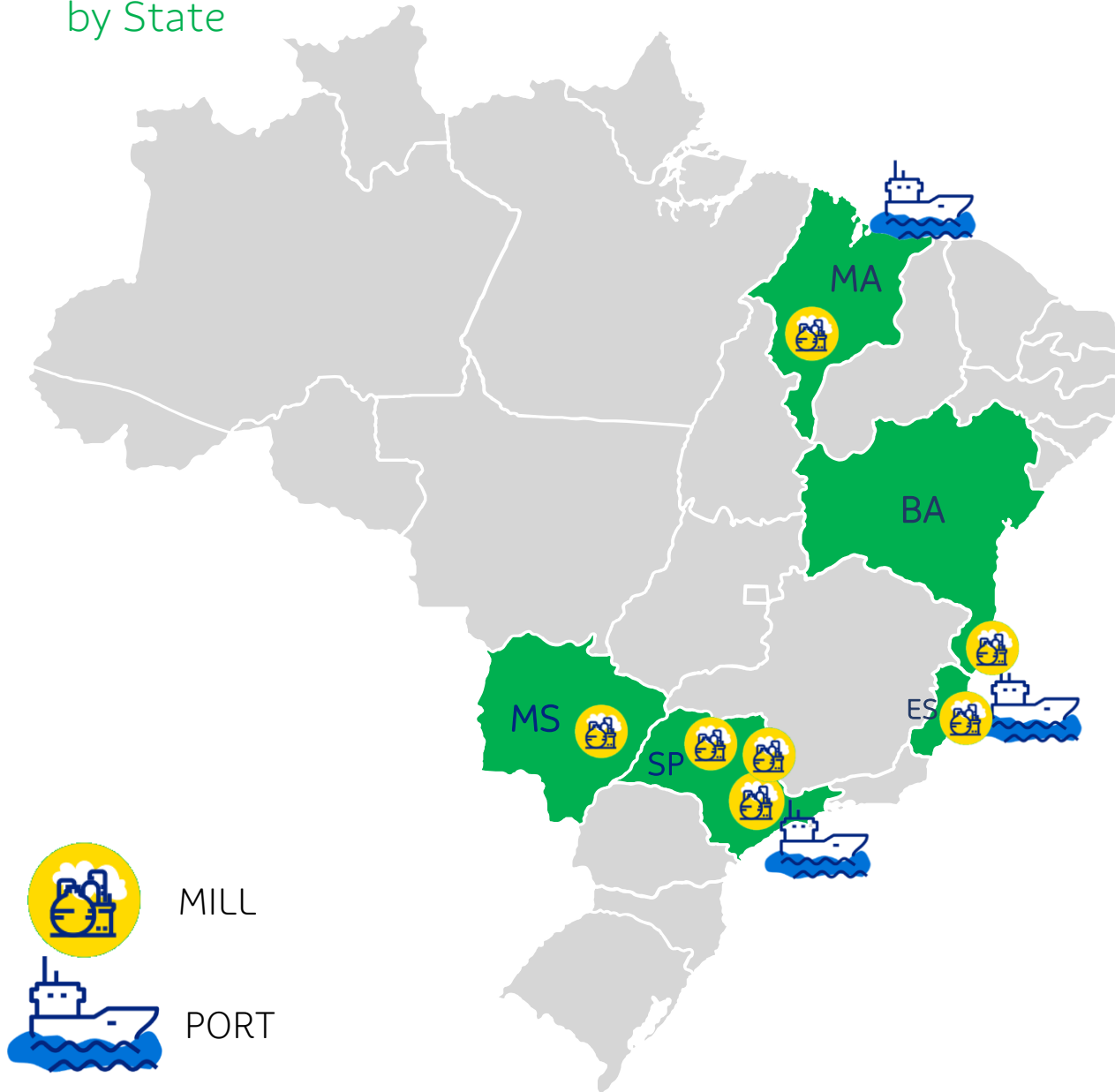
Accumulated COVID-19 cases and deaths by confirmation data
