Meeting minutes: May 27, 2017

Meeting called to order at 9:02 AM

Meeting minutes from September 4, 2016 were approved by John Marsh, seconded by John Snell. Motion carried.

Secretary report: Thank you to Leo Dombrovski for all of his hard work over the years.

Treasurer report: As of 5/1/17 we have a balance of \$10,247.59

LID report: Dan Seanger talked about treating curly leaf. 6.8 acres were treated this year on May 16th, 2017. We are only able to treat the clustered areas and receive a permit from the DNR to treat these zones. We received a grant for this treatment.

Insurance coverage: John Snell volunteered to get quotes for a 6 month insurance policy. John Snell motioned to approve up to \$650 for a 6 month policy, Leo Dombrovski seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Boat landing clean-up: Spring: Jackie Mueller (spelling) volunteered to do spring clean-up.

Fall: Marsha Desick volunteered to do fall clean-up.

Community project ideas: Logo wear: There was some interest; JJ Parker will take this on.

Open House: No real interest in continuing with this.

High water concerns: Concern was raised about the level of the lake and shoreline degradation and erosion issues. Kevin Anderson volunteered to talk with the county about these issues. Shammeneau is currently doing a study to see where all the water is coming from and if there is a solution to the high water issues. JJ Parker will put together a list of names and phone numbers of government agencies for people to call to talk about high water concerns.
