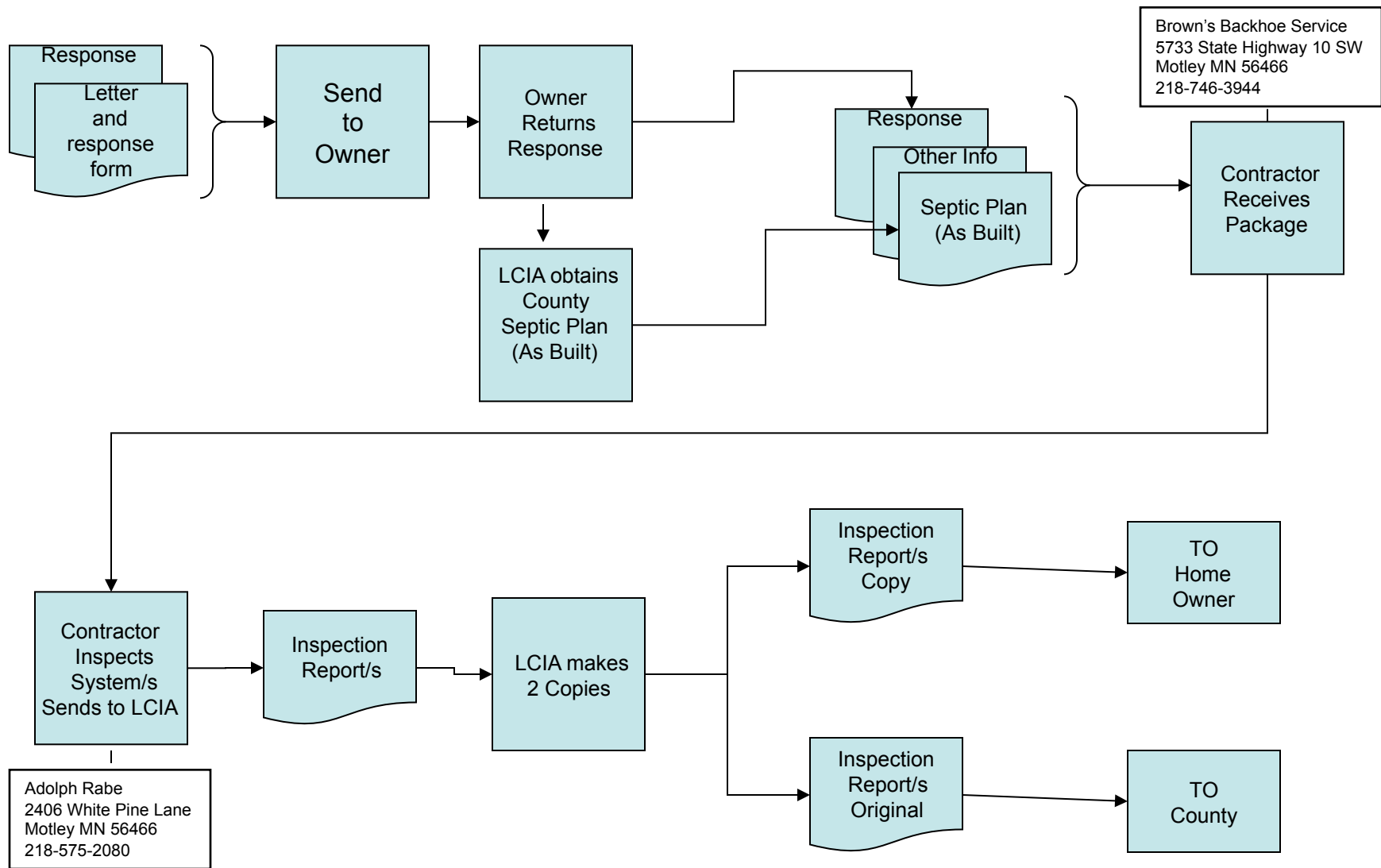

- 7 properties were found to be out of compliance
  - 2 simple, fixed and re-inspected before reported to county
  - 1 had effluent on surface
  - 2 or 3 had “Cess Pool” systems
  - 2 were minor issues such as cracked or partially open cover
