

Chef Hassan pairs great food with sweet success

"Bringing families together is what the Little Chapel of Love is all about, and I couldn't be happier to be a part of that," says Chef Sean Hassan of Rhythm N Food. The Newark native with the expert palate had racked up more than 20 years of experience in the marketing industry before turning to his favorite passions, music and food. Brought on board to cater the 1st Annual Entrepreneur Couples Dinner next month at the Newark Foundry, he promises the menu will be the perfect pairing for this important event.

Building on a catering and personal chef service, Hassan is no stranger to providing delicacies to large crowds. He shares a story of his first big catering event that began as a simple brunch, but quickly turned into a dinner party with that stretched well into the evening. "I basically ended up preparing 8 courses in a kitchen the size of a



In September, we will welcome Avi Telyas of Seaview Development (Suite 107) to the Newark Foundry. Seaview Development will be converting the Krueger-Scott Mansion into a new community called "The Makers Mansion."
