Thank you for your interest in republishing one of our stories! Below you'll find everything you need to know to get started.

Rights

Only original Underscore stories are available for cross-posting. Stories from our partners that appear on our website are not available.

This policy only covers republishing online. For information regarding republishing Underscore.news content in print, email info@underscore.news.

All stories on Underscore.news are embargoed for 24 hours. Please inform us on when you plan to publish the story.

Credit and Tracking

At the top of the story, include a link back to the original story URL on Underscore.news. Example: *This story originally appeared on [Underscore.news](#).*

Credit the author and publication.

Example: *By Author Name, Underscore.news*

Creative Common license Flickr images and images from government agencies may be republished. Otherwise contact info@underscore.news to inquire about rights.

Provide the following footer at the end the story, retaining links:

[Underscore](#) is a nonprofit collaborative reporting team in Portland focused on investigative reporting and Indian Country coverage. We are supported by foundations, corporate sponsors and donor contributions. Follow [Underscore.news](#) on [Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#).

Include the Underscore logo, if possible.

Edits

All links within the story text must be retained.

You are free to choose your own headline provided it makes sense for the story and is not misleading.

You may not edit our stories except to reflect changes in time and style.

Example: Changing “*yesterday*” to “*last week*.” Changing “*Santa Cruz, Calif.*” to “*Santa Cruz, California.*”
