1. Health and Safety Policy Statement

Challenger recognises its duties under current health and safety legislation and will endeavour to meet the requirements of this legislation and maintain a safe and healthy working environment.

- prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health;
- seek continuous improvement in health and safety performance and management through regular monitoring, review and revision of this policy; and
- provide the resources required to make this policy and the health and safety arrangements effective.
- cooperate and work with other employers when working at premises or sites under its control
 in order to ensure the continued health and safety of all those at work; and
- cooperate and work with other employers and their workers, when their workers come to Challenger premises or sites to do work for Challenger, in order to ensure the health and safety of everyone at work.

To help achieve these aims and objectives and ensure all personnel recognise their duties under health and safety legislation, roles and responsibilities and more detailed arrangements have been prepared.
