ABOUT CONSTITUTION DAY

Constitution day which is also known as the Samvidhan Divas is celebrated every year on November 26 to mark the day on which the Constitution of India was adopted. While the adoption of the Constitution took place on November 26, 1949, it came into effect on January 26, 1950. It was on November 19, 2015, when the government of India with the help of a gazette notification declared November 26 as the Constitution Day. There is no public holiday on this day. The draft of the constitution was prepared by the drafting committee under BR Ambedkar's aegis. According to the government notification, the Constitution Day was also a tribute to Ambedkar. Earlier, this day was commemorated as National Law Day, after a resolution by the Supreme Court Bar Association, a lawyers' body, in 1979.





FORMAT OF THE QUIZ

- The virtual quiz will be conducted in three parts-
- 1. Preliminary round
- 2. Semi- final round
- 3. Final round
- All the registered participants will have to give a preliminary round consisting of 30 questions; the questions via google form will be sent to your email id on 26th Nov, 2020.
- The top 6 scorers will qualify for Live quiz semi final round to be held on 29th Nov, 2020 on Google Meet app.
- In case of same marks for any position, the participant who submitted early in time will be considered over the other(s).
- The 6 participants so selected in the preliminary rounds will have to play 4 rounds each in semi-final round.
- The sequence of answering will be allotted before the Live session by the organizing team.
- After the completion of the 4 rounds, cumulative score will be calculated and on that basis top 3 participants will move further into the final rounds.
- The top 3 participants will play 3 final rounds in which the score will be calculated from zero giving a fair chance to the participants to ace.
- The cumulative of the last 3 final rounds will declare the winner between the three participants.

• The marking scheme will be discussed before the commencement of the competition by the host in the meeting itself.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Virtual Quiz will be conducted through Google meet so the participants are requested to be well versed with the app.
- The participants are requested to have proper internet connection, as no network issues will be entertained.
