



Update: current teaching arrangements to continue indefinitely

The metropolitan area coronavirus coordination group decided in its March 24 meeting that [the current coronavirus recommendations and restrictions](#) will be extended until April 30. According to these restrictions, guided recreational activities may only be organized for children born in 2008 and later.

For Espoo School of Art, this means that the teaching arrangements adopted in mid March will continue indefinitely: students born in 2008 and later will receive in-person lessons and older students will remain in distance learning.

The school will continue to follow its meticulous [safety instructions](#), and all classrooms have been carefully arranged so that proper distances can be maintained during lessons.

Due to the coronavirus situation, this year's final project exhibition will be postponed from spring to autumn. Originally, the exhibition was supposed to take place in April and May.

The school is currently looking into how the [potential restrictions in freedom of movement](#) would affect lessons. The restrictions will not be adopted until after Easter, and the school will address them later.
