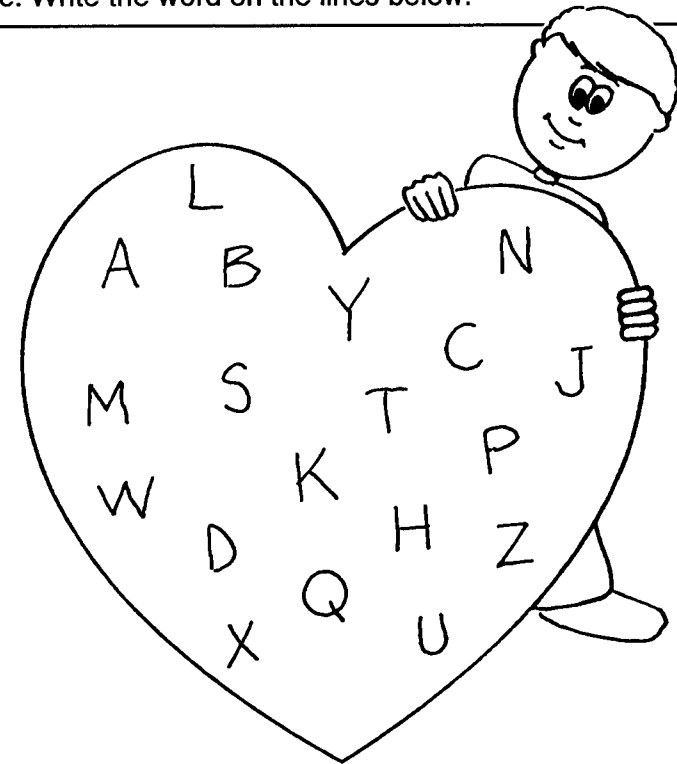

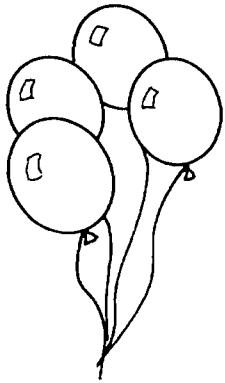

There are 7 letters of the alphabet missing here. Decide what they are. Then unscramble them to make a word that fits the definition above. Write the word on the lines below.

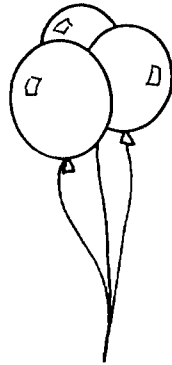
