

FROM THE DESK OF MSGR. STEVE KNOX

Dear Friends in Christ,

Nourished by the Presence of the Lord

In today's reading from Jeremiah, the Prophet says, "Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose hope is in the Lord." How important this trust and hope is during these tumultuous times we live in. When we stay centered in the Lord and allow him to nourish our souls through prayer, the Word of God, and through the sacraments, we receive the graces we need to navigate this life in a spiritually healthy way.

Jeremiah uses an image from nature to describe how our connection with the Lord brings life and keeps us growing even during challenging times, "He is like a tree planted beside the waters that stretches out its roots to the stream: it fears not the heat when it comes, its leaves stay green, in the year of drought it shows no distress, but still bears fruit." The grace of God is like the water from the stream that keeps the tree alive and helps it to continue to produce life. The "fruit" that Jeremiah refers to is virtue. St. Paul will develop this line of thinking as he writes about the fruits of the Holy Spirit. Our connection to the heart and mind of God through prayer and worship allows the Lord to do his work in us. That is where we draw the grace to live the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, and the entire Gospel message. Our efforts are important, but the grace of God is the key.

Jesus knew we would need nourishment and sustenance if we were going to be able to live the Gospel message in daily life. That is why he gave us the gift of himself at the Last Supper. Whenever the Church has gathered to celebrate Mass, it is the Lord Jesus who is present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Holy Eucharist. If we faithfully and humbly receive the Lord week after week, we can trust that we will become more like Jesus, and our lives will bear good fruit.

In order to help us grow in our understanding of the Eucharist and its centrality to our faith, we are going to offer a two-part Discipleship Nights series on the Holy Mass. This will take place on Monday, February 21st, and Monday, February 28th. We will be exploring each part of the Mass and its significance to our relationship with the Lord. In the bulletin article on page 3, you will find more information on the series. You may know someone who is presently disconnected from the life of the Church. I would encourage you to reach out and to invite them to participate. Participation can take place by coming to the Church for the presentations or by connecting through the livestream. The Lord has so much to give us and it is through the Mass that we receive the greatest gift, that is the gift of the Lord Jesus himself.

May the Lord bless all of you with an increase in virtue, especially faith, hope and love!

"A WALK THROUGH THE MASS: UNDERSTANDING THE SACRED LITURGY"

Led by the Parish Priests

Mondays 7:00pm-8:00pm in the Church (also livestreamed)

Monday, February 21st "The Introductory Rite and the Liturgy of the Word" by Msgr. Knox and Fr. Downing

During this two-part series, we will explore why we do what we do during the Mass. During this segment, Msgr. Knox and Fr. Downing will talk about the meaning behind the vestments the priests and deacons wear. They will also talk about the meaning behind the prayers, symbols, and gestures that make up the Introductory Rite of the Mass. Next, they will delve into the Liturgy of the Word which begins with the First Reading and concludes with the Intercessory Prayers (petitions). There will also be time for your questions!

Monday, February 28th "The Liturgy of the Eucharist and the Concluding Rites" by Fr. Grismer and Fr. Downing

During this session, Fr. Grismer and Fr. Downing will teach about all the elements that make up the Liturgy of the Eucharist. This section of the Mass begins with the preparation of the altar and concludes with the reception of Holy Communion. They will also talk about the Concluding Rites which are very brief, but contain much meaning and challenge us to go forth to live and share the Gospel message.



FRIDAY EVENING ROSARY AND ADORATION





TRINITY OUTREACH MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY



Would you value joining others in a conversation about mental health? Would you like to discover what God, Scripture, and the Church have to say in light of the experiences of mental

health challenges? Sign up for *The Sanctuary Course for Catholics* at St. Bridget Parish to be held Wednesday evenings in February. The subject matter feels particularly relevant in these times of heightened anxiety, and the course creates an opportunity to connect with and support each other in meaningful ways.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Sanctuary Course for Catholics is an eight-part course for small groups designed to raise awareness and start conversations in local parishes regarding mental health. It was created in collaboration with Catholic mental health professionals, theologians, and clergy, and offers faith communities the opportunity to learn about mental health and grow in their ability to support members living with mental health challenges. Topics covered include: mental health and mental illness, stigma, recovery, companionship, self-care, and community. The sessions are accompanied by compelling films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians, and psychologists.





2022 Mass Intentions Guidelines

Mass and Flame of Faith Intentions are now open through July 2022 and can be accessed on our website or in person. Mass Intentions are Masses prayed for someone and are read during the intercessory prayers at Mass.

Flame of Faith Intentions for the Presence Lamp in the Sanctuary and/or Vigil Lights in the Adoration Chapel can be requested and burn Sunday through Saturday.

At this time, we are not accepting Intention requests for any dates beyond July 2022. We ask that you do not mail lists or checks with requests for future dates as we cannot hold them or reserve them in advance.

- Limit of 8 Mass Intentions per year per family. Of the 8 Masses, only two can be Sunday Masses or 1 Sunday and 1 Holy Day.
- Only 1 Mass can be prayed for an individual every 21 days.
- "COLLECTIVE MASS" can only be for one individual (not a couple or family).
- The donation for each Mass is \$12.
- The donation for the Presence Lamp is \$12.
- The donation for the 4 Vigil Lights is \$40.
- Reserve Intentions via our website, in person, or by mail.
- Payment can be made online, in person, or by mail.
- All Intention requests are subject to approval by the parish.
