

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Importance of Repentance

Repentance seems to be at the heart of Jesus' message in today's Gospel. Biblical repentance is about turning away from darkness and sin and turning back toward God's merciful embrace. Twice in today's Gospel Jesus expresses the urgency of repentance. When it comes to letting go of sin and opening ourselves to God's mercy, we can easily procrastinate and put off doing what we need to do. Jesus indicates that we do not know the day nor the hour when we will pass from this life, so it is best that we do not procrastinate.

Jesus also highlights God's patience and willingness to give us many opportunities to change and grow. The fig tree is not bearing fruit, and the owner wants to cut it down. The gardener counsels him to be patient and to give it more time so that it might bear fruit. Ultimately, there will come a time of decision and judgement on whether to cut it down. Jesus wants us to know that God is patient and gives us opportunities to grow and bear good fruit by developing virtue; however, if we fail to respond to God's grace and stay stuck in selfishness and vice the consequences will be severe. Our Lord truly desires the salvation of all, but he will not force us to accept his mercy and love. It has to be freely accepted.

We have a great sacrament that helps us connect with Jesus' words in today's Gospel. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is the place where repentance happens in a special way. The priest is there in the person of Jesus to help those who come to confession to receive God's forgiveness. In addition to our regular confession times, we have a special day coming up in our Diocese on Wednesday, April 6th. Be Reconciled Day impacts the whole diocese. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on that day from 9:00am-8:00pm in all parishes of the Rockford Diocese. I have more details on Be Reconciled Day on page three of today's bulletin. It truly is a grace-filled day for those who participate.

As we continue our journey through Lent, may we open our hearts to the grace of God, which always sets us free and brings us life!






