



Dear Friends in Christ.

#### Christmas on the Horizon

This Sunday, we celebrate Gaudete Sunday. It is a Latin word that means "rejoice". The reason we can rejoice is because the birth of Jesus draws near. We highlight this by lighting the rose-colored candle on the Advent wreath, and the priests wear rose-colored vestments. On this Sunday, we recognize the joyful anticipation of the season which culminates in the birth of Jesus on Christmas. Rose is a "brightening" of the ordinary violet and symbolizes joy because the Lord is the light of the world who will scatter all darkness.

We have added some extra times for the Sacrament of Reconciliation leading up to Christmas. I have those listed on page three of today's bulletin. This sacrament is a great way to experience the love and forgiveness of the Lord and to purify our hearts leading up to Christmas. In addition to experiencing the forgiveness of our sins, we are also strengthened to forgive others.

#### **January Spiritual Enrichment Days**

On Saturday, January 14th, we will have a Women's Spiritual Enrichment Day in the Parish Center. The following Saturday, January 21st, we will have a Men's Spiritual Enrichment Day for the men of the parish. I have the information/registration forms on page 4 and 5 of today's bulletin. Over the years, I have found these days to be very helpful for those who participate. Talks and reflections are mainly given by the parishioners and the priests. We seek to make the talks down to earth and relevant. Since we will be in a new year, this will be a great way to be strengthened in our faith as we enter into 2023.


#### **Reaching Out and Inviting**




#### SAINT RITA CHAPLET



### **2023 Mass Intentions Guidelines**

Mass and Flame of Faith Intentions are now open through May 2023 and can be accessed on our website or in person. Mass Intentions are Masses prayed for someone and are read during the intercessory prayers at Mass.

Flame of Faith Intentions for the Presence Lamp in the Sanctuary and/or Vigil Lights in the Adoration Chapel can be requested and burn Sunday through Saturday.

At this time, we are not accepting Intention requests for any dates beyond May 2023. We ask that you do not mail lists or checks with requests for future dates as we cannot hold them or reserve them in advance.

- Limit of 9 Mass Intentions per year per family. Of the 9 Masses, only two can be Sunday Masses or 1 Sunday and 1 Holy Day.
- Only 1 Mass can be prayed for an individual every 21 days.
- "COLLECTIVE MASS" can only be for one individual (not a couple or family).
- The donation for each Mass is \$12.
- The donation for the Presence Lamp is \$12.
- The donation for the 4 Vigil Lights is \$40.
- Reserve Intentions via our website, in person, or by mail.
- Payment can be made online, in person, or by mail.
- All Intention requests are subject to approval by the parish.
